WRITING TASK

This is a replica of the writing task contained within paper 2 of your English Language exam which you will sit at the end of year 11.

In this section you will be assessed for the quality of your writing skills. For each question, 12 marks are awarded for communication and organisation (including utilising an effective 5-point plan AND injecting all of those persuasive devices and INAFOREST techniques); 8 marks are awarded for vocabulary, sentence structure, punctuation and spelling. - A) You are asked to write a letter to your local MP about the local lockdown measures in response to the Coronavirus. You should consider different age groups and how they are affected; you can write about the positives or the negatives of the lockdown. [20 marks]
- B) Write a speech for your year group about social media. [20 marks]
