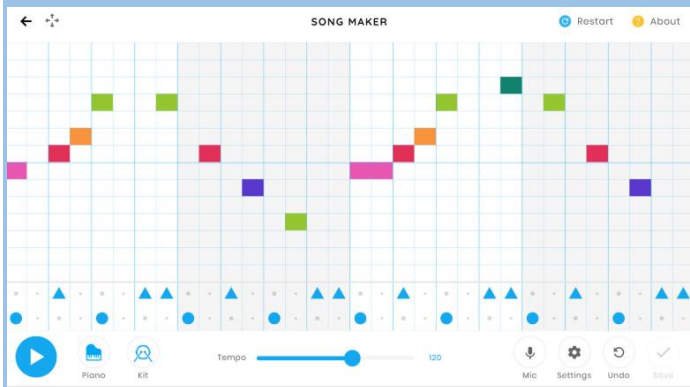


## Key stage 3

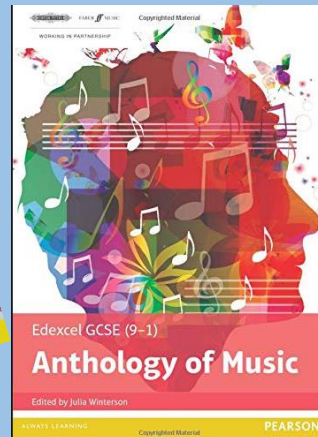
