Proposed Hazard Reduction (HR) for 2026

A planned hazard reduction burn is being considered from Gorricks Run to Bakers Creek. This proposal is still under negotiation, as the area may be too large and could require adjustment. Further updates will be provided in 2026. As we can never assume that our Hazard Reduction proposals will be approved or included in the 2026 HR program, we are encouraging property owners to take proactive steps. In the true spirit of St Albans resilience and self-reliance, we're promoting the use of Hazard Reduction certificates (HRCs) so that landowners can manage their own properties and create protective buffer zones around their homes. This helps reduce the risk and impact of future wildfires.

1st October to

31st March.

Fire Permits are

required

during this period.



Hazard Reduction Certificates (HRC) Updated Information

Landowners may apply for a Hazard Reduction Certificate to conduct burns on their own property or request assistance from the RFS (availability permitting). Burns are not permitted in areas impacted by Gosper's Mountain fires due to the required 7-year regeneration period. More information and the application form are available via the link below.

Community First Response Vehicle

The SAPC is currently being upgraded to serve as a Community First Response vehicle.

This will allow our crew to provide initial triage and first aid while NSW Ambulance services are on their way. The vehicle is being fitted with dedicated first-aid equipment, and several of our crew have already completed advanced first-aid training through TACMed.

There is also the possibility of further training being arranged in partnership with RFS and NSW Ambulance Services to continue improving our first-aid capability.
