USGA RULES GOVERN ALL PLAY EXCEPT WHERE MODIFIED BY LOCAL RULES



GROUND UNDER REPAIR

- The following cultivated areas are mandatory relief (flower beds):
 - Hole #5 right of the green
- · French drains and Irrigation line areas
- · White circled areas deemed ground under repair

OBSTRUCTIONS: Any artificial surfaces, including roads and paths except for items that define out of bounds. If stance or swing is affected by surfaces that include retaining walls, black tubing, relief may be taken.

OUT OF BOUNDS: Margins are defined by white stakes or boundary fences

- 4 Hour Pace of Play or less. Please stay up with the group ahead of you.
- Appropriate golf attire is required including a collared or golf appropriate shirt.

EMBEDDED BALL: Anywhere "through the green"

ELECTRONIC MEASURING DEVICES: Allowed for regular and tournament play at Island View.

THE FIRST HOLE

HCP 15/3

The first hole is the shortest and easiest-to-score par 5 on the golf course. Trees line both sides of the fairway, with two fairway bunkers on the right, and three bunkers surrounding the putting surface.

THE SECOND HOLE

HCP 7

This par 4 plays uphill to the landing area in the fairway. Two fairway bunkers are on the left side of the fairway, and trees down the right side. A straight tee shot is required.

THE THIRD HOLE

HCP 1

This is the number 1 handicap hole and the view is spectacular! Out of bounds and two fairway bunkers flank the right side of the hole, and trees line the left side.

THE FOURTH HOLE

HCP 17

Hole 4 is a short par 3 that plays to a green that is sloped from back to front, and surrounded by bunkers. The ideal play is to keep the ball below the hole so you can guarantee an uphill putt.




THE FIFTH HOLE

HCP 11/15

This tee shot requires strategy. Trees line both sides of the fairway, and out of bounds looms right.

THE SIXTH HOLE

HCP 9/13

This is our signature hole at IVGC. It requires a tee shot over water to a kidney-shaped green. A pot bunker protects the front middle portion of the green.

THE SEVENTH HOLE

HCP 3/9

An elevated tee require a lengthy and accurate tee shot. Trees line both sides of the fairway, and each side has a fairway bunker.

THE EIGHTH HOLE

HCP 13/11

An elevated tee shot has you hitting to a generous landing area. The more aggressive your tee shot, the more trouble you bring into play - there are fairway bunkers on either side of this hole.

THE NINTH HOLE

HCP 5

Your tee shot will determine how you play this hole. A severe dogleg right requires a tee shot to carry over, or go around, a large oak tree.



THE TENTH HOLE

HCP 6/12

This par 4 moves slightly left to right. Trees line both sides of the fairway, and a large fairway bunker forces you to play to the left side.

THE ELEVENTH HOLE

HCP 16/18

This par 3 requires a tee shot that favors the left/center of the green. Short of the green, on the right, is a majestic oak tree. Take a moment on this green to enjoy the view of the island on Lake Waconia.

THE TWELFTH HOLE

HCP 14/10

This short par 4 requires precision off the tee. Trees line both sides of the fairway and three fairway bunkers line the left side.

THE THIRTEENTH HOLE

HCP 10/4

This par 4 requires you to carry, or play left, to avoid the water hazard off the tee. Fairway bunkers are placed down the left side, and the water hazard runs down the right.

THE FOURTEENTH HOLE

HCP 2

This longest par 5 requires accuracy and length. With out of bounds down the left side and a water hazard on the right, a good tee shot will set you up for the rest of the hole.

THE FIFTEENTH HOLE

HCP 12/6

This short, tight par 4 has a water hazard and trees lining the entire left side of the fairway, and trees lining the right.

THE SIXTEENTH HOLE

HCP 18/16

This shortest par 3 hole at IVGC requires a tee shot from an elevated tee. This green has two levels and is protected by 2 bunkers. Trees on both sides create a pretty view of this great par 3 hole.

THE SEVENTEENTH HOLE

HCP 4/14

This demanding par 5 requires a good uphill tee shot to a tree-lined fairway. The second shot must also be accurate down the hill to the right-sloping fairway.

THE EIGHTEENTH HOLE

HCP 8

The finishing hole requires both length and accuracy off the tee. Trees line the right side of the fairway and a large fairway bunker awaits on the left side.
