Some of the things from 2019 were:

- Helped 4 churches with construction projects.
- Accomplished 12 weeks of Spanish classes, heard 122 live Spanish sermons, countless meetings and conversations with Spanish friends and neighbors.

- Helped start a new home church.
- Finished our time working with the Weavers

What's a Fort House anyway?

We are making some gift bags to distribute to some Gypsy people who live in huts and tents around the city. Titus calls them "Fort Houses" he's a typical boy right, in his mind they look pretty cool. The bags will have bread, sausage, fruit, and the gospel so pray for us as we reach out to them. The greatest gift they could receive is salvation. So far the ones I've spoken to have never heard the gospel and they're open to it. We'll see what God does.
