  - Northern tier counties will have a very good winter.
  - Southern tier counties:
    - Nov 7-20, wet, chance of snow Nov 10-16.
    - Nov 21-25, sunny, moderate temperatures, dry.
    - Nov 26-30, rain, temps drop Nov 29-30, possible 3 inches of snow.
    - Dec 1-4, light snow and cold.
    - Dec 5-11, snow (1-2") & cold.
    - Dec 13-15, warmer, rain.
    - Dec 16-17, first big snow, 4-8 inches possible, single digit temps.
    - Dec 18-19, mild, chance of rain.
    - Dec 20-31, chance of snow, 8-10 inches total if it happens.
      - Dec 26-31, sub-zero temps at night.
      - Dec 27, trails predicted to open.
    - Jan 1-3, cold and dry.
    - Jan 4-10, two Alberta Clipper systems, 1-2" of snow.
    - Jan 11-18, sub-zero temperatures, Lake Koshkonong finally freezes over.
    - Jan 19-24, low temps, 2-4" snow.
    - Jan 25-Feb 1, below average temperatures and dry.
    - February looks very active, with snow often.
