#### OLD BUSINESS:

- Aaron Lenox updated on the scholarship committee:
  - The scholarship award process is going to be kept in-house with the Sundowners. We've already missed the deadline to go through the school this year, plus it can widen the applicant pool.
  - The application will consist of an essay, with the winner selected based on the strength of that essay. The essays main feature should be how the applicant is connected to the Sundowners. For example, parents are members, trail runs through a family members farm, etc.
  - Applications will be accepted at a later date, since applicants will be asked for proof of successful participation in some kind of post-secondary training or education program (e.g., technical school, college, etc.). Continuing students may also be eligible, not only recent high school graduates.
  - Some rules and other details are still being worked out, but will be available on sundownerssnowmobilers.com when finalized.
