OPERATING YOUR ENCLOSURE

Follow these simple steps for safe and easy operation.

1



LOWERING THE CURTAIN

Lower the curtain to the ground with the provided crank handle.

2



SECURING THE WEIGHT BAR

Insert the pin(s) on both sides of the weight bar to lock the curtain in place.

TENSIONING THE CURTAIN

Use the crank handle to pull the curtain taut. This keeps the fabric secure and looking its best.

4



RAISING THE CURTAIN

To raise the curtain, reverse the crank to release tension, remove the lower pins, and roll the curtain up evenly and smoothly.



WINDY CONDITIONS

If you need to roll curtains up in windy conditions, have another set of hands to help guide the curtain onto the roller tube. Wind can cause the curtain to roll up improperly, leaving wrinkles in the fabric or clear when rolled back down.



CLEANING & MAINTENANCE

KEEP IT CLEAN, KEEP IT CLEAR



REGULAR DUSTING

Keep free of daily dust buildup with a soft duster (Swiffer works great, but must not have any chemicals on it). This is especially important on the windows.



WEEKLY WINDOW CLEANING

Clean the windows weekly or as needed, inside and out, using a clean, damp microfiber cloth. NEVER use anything abrasive on the windows.



FABRIC CLEANING

Clean the fabric using water and a mild detergent with a soft bristle brush (such as a car wash type brush).



WINDOW POLISH

Once a month, polish the windows on the inside and outside with Pledge® furniture polish. This acts as a water and dirt repellent while keeping the glass looking nice and clear.



ANNUAL DEEP CLEAN

The entire enclosure should receive a deep clean inside and outside once per calendar year. Follow the steps above for best results.



PROTECT YOUR INVESTMENT

Routine care and proper operation will help extend the life of your enclosure and keep it looking its best for years to come.



HELPFUL TIPS

- ✓ Raise or lower all curtains together whenever possible. Having some up and some down on a windy day can cause damage.
- ✓ If operating in windy conditions, have someone help guide the curtain onto the roller tube for a smooth, even roll.
- ✓ Keep tracks and zipper areas clean and free of dirt and debris.
- ✓ Inspect hardware and fasteners periodically to ensure everything is secure and functioning properly.

AVOID THESE

- ✗ Abrasive cleaners or scrub brushes
- ✗ Paper towels or rough cloths on clear vinyl
- ✗ Pressure washing the windows
- ✗ Pulling on the pin lanyards
- ✗ Rolling curtains up unevenly
- ✗ Operating the enclosure in high winds



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
