CLEANING & MAINTENANCE



WASH WITH MILD SOAP & WATER

Use mild soap (Dawn®) and clean water to wash the vinyl and fabric.



USE A SOFT BRUSH OR MICROFIBER CLOTH

Gently clean the surface. Avoid stiff brushes.



RINSE THOROUGHLY

Rinse with clean water to remove all soap and residue.



ALLOW TO DRY COMPLETELY

Make sure the curtain is completely dry before rolling up or storing.



REMOVE GRIME & DEBRIS

Remove bugs, road grime, and debris regularly to extend the life of the material.

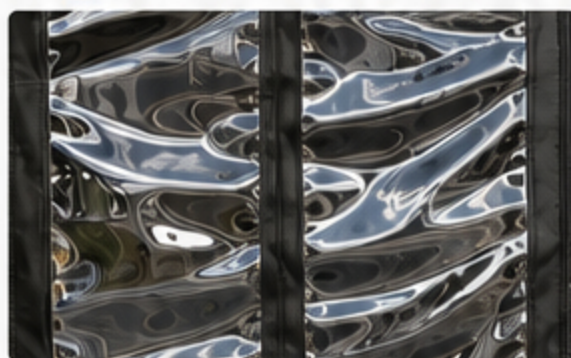


HELPFUL TIPS

- ✓ Roll curtains evenly every time.
- ✓ Store only when completely dry.
- ✓ Remove excessive snow or ice before operating.
- ✓ Avoid dragging the curtain across concrete or asphalt.
- ✓ Contact us if repairs or adjustments are ever needed.



CLEAR WINDOW CARE



- ✓ Clean with a soft microfiber cloth.
- ✓ Treat the clear vinyl with **Pledge® Furniture Polish** several times each year.
- ✓ Pledge helps maintain clarity while repelling dust and dirt.
- ✓ Clean both the inside and outside surfaces.
- ✓ Never use paper towels or abrasive cleaners on clear vinyl.

PERIODIC INSPECTION



CHECK SNAPS & FASTENERS

Inspect snaps and fasteners to ensure they are secure and working properly.



INSPECT ZIPPERS

Check zippers for smooth operation and keep clean.



VERIFY MOUNTING HARDWARE

Ensure all mounting hardware remains tight and secure.



INSPECT STRAPS & BUCKLES

Check straps and buckles for wear and proper function.



REPLACE WORN HARDWARE

Replace any damaged or worn hardware promptly to avoid future issues.



AVOID THESE

- ✗ Pressure washers
- ✗ Bleach
- ✗ Harsh chemicals
- ✗ Rolling the curtain up while wet
- ✗ Paper towels on clear vinyl
- ✗ Sharp objects contacting the curtain
- ✗ Excessive force on zippers or snaps
