Scene Assessment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pauses and assesses scene for safety. 	<i>Scene is safe!</i>	<input type="checkbox"/>
Standard Precautions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Uses disposable gloves (can be verbalized). 		<input type="checkbox"/>
Introduce Self/Permission to Help	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Introduces self to injured person. Asks if it is okay to help. 	<i>Person agrees to be helped!</i> <i>Normal mental status!</i> <i>No breathing difficulty noted!</i>	<input type="checkbox"/>
Severe Bleeding Assessment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Quickly scans body for severe bleeding. 	<i>Heavy flowing bleeding from an exposed forearm wound!</i>	<input type="checkbox"/>
EMS Activation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Asks a bystander to activate EMS. 		<input type="checkbox"/>
Direct Pressure	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Applies firm pressure with clean pad directly on bleeding site. 	<i>Bleeding has soaked through pad!</i>	<input type="checkbox"/>
Additional Pads	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Leaving first pad in place, applies second pad. Re-applies direct pressure. 	<i>Bleeding is controlled!</i>	<input type="checkbox"/>
Pressure Bandage	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Wraps bandage around limb and over dressings to maintain direct pressure. Monitors limb to see if bandage is wrapped too tight. 		<input type="checkbox"/>
Tissue Color	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Looks at injured person's face. With darker skin tones, checks palms, fingernails, or inside lip. 	<i>Tissue color is pale!</i>	<input type="checkbox"/>
Skin Temperature	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Uses back of hand to check temperature on injured person's forehead. 	<i>Skin temperature is cool!</i> <i>Wound starts to bleed again and direct pressure is unable to control it!</i>	<input type="checkbox"/>
Tourniquet	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Uses a tourniquet. (verbalized) 		<input type="checkbox"/>
