YOUTH GROUP EXPECTATIONS

- 1. Respect. We respect God, respect ourselves, respect others, and respect the facilities. We want to create an atmosphere where all students are welcome and respected so that they will want to come back to another youth ministry event and be able to encounter God personally.
- 2. Be present. Silence your cell phone, soak in the message from God's Word, and interact with your fellow youth group peeps.
- 3. Participate. When we're at youth group, we're all in.

CELL PHONES/ELECTRONICS POLICY

While we acknowledge cell phones and other electronic devices can be incredibly helpful at times, we also realize that more often than not they are a distraction from being fully present. Therefore, students may use their cell phones before and after youth ministry events and traveling to and from youth ministry events. They may not be used at any other time unless approved by Pastor Brandon. Our Youth Ministry leaders will set the example by also not using their cell phones, except for approved ministry-related tasks such as taking photos and videos at ministry events.

MEETING LOCATION & TIMES

For most of our youth group times, we meet in the youth room—the modular building next to the church. We typically will meet from 6-7:30pm on Wednesdays, both Middle School and High School together. We intend to begin and end on time to respect everyone's time. Therefore, please encourage your kids to show up early (doors officially open 30 minutes before youth group begins). If students wish to stay after and hang out, we would love for them to stay.

FORMS

There are three required forms I will need you to fill out for each child in our youth ministry: a Medical Release Form, a Photo Release Form, and a Parent Partnership Survey. To participate in an off-site activity, we will need to have an up-to-date medical release form on file. The Photo Release Form is so that we can post photos of students on the website, social media, etc., to showcase all the cool things we're doing in youth ministry. The Parent Partnership Survey is helpful in finding ways for us to partner together in the discipleship of your child(ren). These forms will eventually be on our church website, gracehuxley.com.
