

# Horsemanship & Riding Activity at Bibby Ranch, LLC

In order, for you or your child to participate this form must be completed.

#### **Program Policies**

- Payment in full is required at the time of registration. Lesson fees are due monthly, by the first lesson of the month. All lesson packages will be a monthly flat rate, rather than a per lesson rate. Single lesson and trail ride fee are due at time of each activity.
- If a student withdraws from the program, a partial refund may be given, minus a 10% rebooking fee, pending the program spot(s) are resold. **Advance notice is required.**
- Cancelation Policy: STRICTLY ENFORCED Lessons MUST be cancelled at least <u>24 hours</u> in advance to qualify for a make-up lesson. Lessons cancelled with less than 24 hours' notice or no calls/no shows will be charged full price for the missed lesson. Students that miss 2 lessons in a row without notice or excuse may lose their weekly spot should trainer have a waitlist for vacancies.
- Make-up classes are not available for participants who have to miss a class due to vacation, other school activities, illness, etc.
- You are responsible for the cost of your lesson, whether or not you attend.
- Another person may not take the registered student's place.
- If parents wish to ride, they must be registered for the class.
- All children must be signed in and out each day of the session by a responsible party. (The person who brings the child or picks them up.)
- Programs will not automatically be canceled due to weather. In the event of rain, lessons, trail rides and camps may be rescheduled.

#### **Participant Guidelines**

- All student must be at least 48" tall, weigh <u>no more than 185 pounds</u> and be at least 6 years of age and older.
- All student under the age of 18 must wear ASTM (American Safety & Testing Materials) approved riding helmets, while mounted at all times. Helmets are recommended for adults over 18, but not required. Helmets are provided by Bibby Ranch, LLC.
- Students are required to wear long pants.
- Students must wear hard-soled shoes or boots with a low heel and light tread or smooth sole when working with horses on ground and mounted. No tennis shoes, sandals permitted around horses.
- Only staff and scheduled volunteers are permitted inside horse area and corrals, unless an instructor is present and permission to enter is granted.
- Summer Camps: Students must bring a sack lunch, snacks and drinks. Plenty of water will be provided throughout the day for day camps. Other items recommended sunscreen, lip balm insect repellent.
- (COVID-19) Participants must bring their own facemask. Students will be assigned their own tack, grooming supplies, and ranch tools when participating in day camps or semi-private group lessons and trail.

According to NEISS (National Electronic Injury Surveillance Systems of United States mer Products) horse activities rank 64th among the activities of people relative to injuries that result in a stay hospitals. Related injuries can be severe, requiring more hospital days and resulting in more lasting residual than injuries in other activities.
more p distant where moven unders natura	CURE OF RIDING HORSES – No horse is a completely safe horse. Horses are 5 to 15 times larger, 20 to 40 times lowerful, and 3 to 4 times faster than a human. If a rider falls from a horse to ground it will generally be at a see of from 31/2 to 51/2 feet, and the impact may result in injury to the rider. Horseback riding is the only sport on much smaller, weaker predator animal (human) tries to impose its will on, and become on unit of nent with, another much larger, stronger prey animal with a mind of its own (horse) and each has a limited tanding of the other. If a horse is frightened or provoked it may divert from its training and act according to its survival instincts which may include, but are not limited to: stopping short, changing directions or speed at ifting its weight; bucking; rearing; kicking; biting; or running from danger.



- **E. RIDER RESPONSIBILITY** Upon mounting a horse and taking up the reins, the RIDER is in primary control of the horse. The RIDER'S safety largely depends upon his/her ability to carry out simple instructions, and his/her ability to remain balanced aboard the moving animal. The RIDER shall be responsible for his/her own safety.
- **F. CONDITIONS OF NATURE** BIBBY RANCH, LLC is NOT responsible for total or partial acts, occurrences, or elements of nature that can scare a horse, cause it to fall, or react in some other unsafe way. SOME EXAMPLES ARE: thunder, lightning, rain, wind, wild and domestic animals, insects, reptiles, which may walk, run, fly near, bite and/or sting a horse or person; and irregular footing on out-of-door groomed or wild land which is subject to constant change in condition according to weather, temperature, and natural and man-made changes in landscape.
- **G. INPSECTION OF PREMISES** RIDER has inspected BIBBY RANCH, LLC facilities and trails and is satisfied that all premises conditions are reasonably safe for RIDER'S intended purpose, usage and presence upon the BIBBY RANCH, LLC premises.
- **H. PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR WARNING** I have been fully warned and advised by BIBBY RANCH, LLC that the RIDER should purchase and wear protective headgear (riding helmet), and that the wearing of such headgear while mounting, riding, dismounting, and otherwise being around horses, may prevent or reduce severity of some head injuries and even prevent death from happening as the result of a fall or other occurrence. Minors 18 and under are required to wear protective headgear.
- **I. LIABILITY RELEASE** In consideration of BIBBY RANCH, LLC allowing my participation in this activity, under the terms set forth herein, I, the RIDER, and the parent or guardian thereof if a minor, do agree to hold harmless and release BIBBY RANCH, LLC its owners, agents, employees, officers, members, premises owners, insurers, and affiliated organizations from legal liability due to BIBBY RANCH, LLC ordinary negligence; and I do further agree *that except in the event of BIBBY RANCH, LLC gross negligence and willful and wanton misconduct, I shall not bring any claims, demand, legal actions and causes of action, against LORI BIBBINS/BIBBY RANCH, LLC and/or its associates, for any economic and non-economic losses due to bodily injury, death, property damage, sustained by me and/or my minor child or legal ward in relation to the premises and operations of BIBBY RANCH, LLC to include while riding, handling, or otherwise being near horses owned by or in the care, custody and control of BIBBY RANCH, LLC.*

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#### **Barn Rules:**

Students and parents - Please read memorize and abide by the following rules as we strive to give everyone a safe and fun learning experience. Rules and regulations are in place for the safety of all riders and horses. Barn rules are also posted on/in the tack room for easy reference.

- 1. NO SMOKING or ALCHOLIC BEVERAGES.
- 2. Children MUST be supervised by a parent or legal guardian at ALL times.
- 3. For safety reasons, spectators must remain at the viewing area (Top Swing over-looking arena) while lessons or equine activities commence, and all children must remain under direct supervision by parent or guardian at ALL TIMES.
- 4. Children age 8 and over may be dropped off for activities with trainer's consent.
- 5. Listen to your trainer and follow their instructions at all times. Riders not following instructions or acting in an unsafe or disrespectful manner will be asked to dismount or cease activity immediately. This rule is for your safety, the safety of other participants, and the horse's well-being.
- 6. All riders regardless of age, participating in mounted activities MUST wear an ASTM approved riding helmet at all times while mounted. (We do provide helmets)
- 7. Do not enter arena or horse stalls/pens unless specifically instructed by your trainer.
- 8. Please do not bring any personal pets to the ranch. If you must, they must stay in the vehicle.
- 9. Please respect this property. Place trash in designated receptacles.
- 10. PLEASE DRIVE SLOWLY.
- 11. No running, screaming, loud noises, or horseplay. This includes while in direct contact with the horse as well as while in areas around the horses.
- 12. Please refrain from opening umbrellas while lessons are in progress as they can cause the horses to spook.
- 13. Ask before petting ANY of the horses or animals.
- 14. **DO NOT feed ANYTHING to the horses.** This includes any hay found on the ground. We appreciate your help in keeping our horses safe and healthy!
- 15. Do not enter miniature ponies pen or other any animal pens without permission.
- 16. When approaching a horse, speak softly so as not to startle it. A frightened horse may kick or pull back.
- 17. Approach horse from the side, never from directly in front or behind them.
- 18. Horses are to be tied in designated areas only.
- 19. Never cross in front of the horse while it is tied up.
- 20. After you enter any gate, close and latch it behind you.
- 21. Do not let tack drag in the dirt or leave bridles/reins on the ground. Please return your tack/supplies to the tack room when you are finished using them.
