



Riding Activity at Bibby Ranch

In order for you or your child to participate, this form must be completed.

Program Policies

- Payment in full is required at the time of registration. Lesson fees are due monthly, by the first lesson of the month. **All lesson packages will be a monthly flat rate, rather than a per lesson rate.** Single lesson and trail ride fee are due at time of each activity.
- If a student withdraws from the program, a partial refund can be given, minus a 10% rebooking fee, pending the program spot(s) are resold. Advance notice is required.
- Make-up classes are not available for participants who have to miss a class due to vacation, illness, etc.
- You are responsible for the cost of your lesson, whether or not you attend.
- Another person may not take the registered student's place.
- If parents wish to ride, they must be registered for the class.
- All children must be signed in and out each day of the session by a responsible party. (The person who brings the child or picks them up.)
- Programs will not automatically be canceled due to weather. In the event of rain, lessons, trail rides and camps may be rescheduled.

Participant Guidelines

- All students must be at least 48" tall, weigh no more than 220 pounds and be at least 6 years of age and older.
- All students under the age of 18 must wear ASTM (American Safety & Testing Materials) approved riding helmets while mounted at all times. Helmets are recommended for adults over 18, but not required. Helmets are provided by Bibby Ranch.
- Students are required to wear long pants.
- Students must wear hard-soled shoes or boots with a low heel and light tread or smooth sole when working with horses on ground and mounted. No tennis shoes, sandals permitted around horses.
- Only staff and scheduled volunteers are permitted inside horse area and corrals, unless an instructor is present and permission to enter is granted.
- Students must bring a sack lunch, snacks and drinks. Plenty of water will be provided throughout the day for day camps.
- (COVID-19) Participants must bring their own facemask. Students will be assigned their own tack, grooming supplies, and ranch tools when participating in day camps or semi-private group lessons and trail.

RANCH RULES

- No smoking.
- No alcoholic beverages.
- Grain is to be fed only by the instructor.
- Treats are fine to feed, with instructor approval.
- Please put your stuff away.
- Children must be supervised at all times, unless taking a lesson.
- **Please drive slowly.**
- If you open ANY gate, please close it!

HORSE RIDING AGREEMENT AND LIABILITY RELEASE FORM

SERIOUS INJURY MAY RESULT FROM YOUR PARTICIPATION IN THIS ACTIVITY. BIBBY RANCH DOES NOT GUARANTEE YOUR SAFETY OR THAT OF YOUR HORSE. IT IS HEREBY AGREED TO AS FOLLOWS THAT:

A. REGISTRATION OF RIDERS AND AGREEMENT PURPOSE I, the following individual hereinafter known as the "RIDER", and the parents or legal guardians thereof if a minor, do hereby voluntarily request and agree to participate in horse riding on the premises at BIBBY RANCH, and that this RIDER will ride horses provided by Bibby Ranch today and on all future dates:

B. AGREEMENT SCOPE AND TERRITORY AND DEFINITIONS – This agreement shall be legally binding upon me the registered RIDER, and the parents or legal guardians thereof if a minor, my heirs, estate, assigns, including all minor children, and personal representatives; and it shall be interpreted according to the laws of California and San Diego County. Any disputes by the RIDER shall be litigated in and venue shall be California and San Diego County.

The term "HORSE" herein shall refer to all equine species. The term "HORSEBACK RIDING" or "RIDING" herein shall refer to riding or otherwise handling of horses and ponies whether from the ground or mounted. The term "RIDER" shall herein refer to a person who rides a horse mounted or otherwise handles or comes near a horse from the ground.

The terms "I", "me", "my" shall herein refer to the above registered rider and the parents or legal guardians thereof if a minor.

C. ACTIVITY RISK CLASSIFICATION – Horseback riding is classified as RUGGED ADVENTURE RECREATIONAL SPORT ACTIVITY, and that there are numerous obvious and non-obvious inherent risks always present in such activity despite all safety precautions. According to NEISS (National Electronic Injury Surveillance Systems of United States Consumer Products) horse activities rank 64th among the activities of people relative to injuries that result in a stay at U.S. hospitals. Related injuries can be severe, requiring more hospital days and resulting in more lasting residual effects than injuries in other activities.

D. NATURE OF RIDING HORSES – No horse is a completely safe horse. Horses are 5 to 15 times larger, 20 to 40 times more powerful, and 3 to 4 times faster than a human. If a rider falls from a horse to ground it will generally be at a distance of from 31/2 to 51/2 feet, and the impact may result in injury to the rider. Horseback riding is the only sport where on much smaller, weaker predator animal (human) tries to impose its will on, and become on unit of movement with, another much larger, stronger prey animal with a mind of its own (horse) and each has a limited understanding of the other. If a horse is frightened or provoked it may divert from its training and act according to its natural survival instincts which may include, but are not limited to: stopping short, changing directions or speed at will; shifting its weight; bucking; rearing; kicking; biting; or running from danger.

E. RIDER RESPONSIBILITY – Upon mounting a horse and taking up the reins, the RIDER is in primary control of the horse. The RIDER'S safety largely depends upon his/her ability to carry out simple instructions, and his/her ability to remain balanced aboard the moving animal. The RIDER shall be responsible for his/her own safety.



F. CONDITIONS OF NATURE – BIBBY RANCH is NOT responsible for total or partial acts, occurrences, or elements of nature that can scare a horse, cause it to fall, or react in some other unsafe way. SOME EXAMPLES ARE: thunder, lightning, rain, wind, wild and domestic animals, insects, reptiles, which may walk, run, fly near, bite and/or sting a horse or person; and irregular footing on out-of-door groomed or wild land which is subject to constant change in condition according to weather, temperature, and natural and man-made changes in landscape.

G. INSPECTION OF PREMISES – RIDER has inspected BIBBY RANCH facilities and trails and is satisfied that all premises conditions are reasonably safe for RIDER’S intended purpose, usage and presence upon the BIBBY RANCH premises.

H. PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR WARNING – I have been fully warned and advised by BIBBY RANCH that the RIDER should purchase and wear protective headgear (riding helmet), and that the wearing of such headgear while mounting, riding, dismounting, and otherwise being around horses, may prevent or reduce severity of some head injuries and even prevent death from happening as the result of a fall or other occurrence. Minors 18 and under are required to wear protective headgear.

I. LIABILITY RELEASE – In consideration of BIBBY RANCH allowing my participation in this activity, under the terms set forth herein, I, the RIDER, and the parent or guardian thereof if a minor, do agree to hold harmless and release BIBBY RANCH, its owners, agents, employees, officers, members, premises owners, insurers, and affiliated organizations from legal liability due to BIBBY RANCH ordinary negligence; and I do further agree *that except in the event of BIBBY RANCH gross negligence and willful and wanton misconduct*, I shall not bring any claims, demand, legal actions and causes of action, against LORI BIBBINS/BIBBY RANCH and/or its associates, for any economic and non-economic losses due to bodily injury, death, property damage, sustained by me and/or my minor child or legal ward in relation to the premises and operations of BIBBY RANCH, to include while riding, handling, or otherwise being near horses owned by or in the care, custody and control of BIBBY RANCH.

I give my full permission for Lori Bibbins (Bibby Ranch) and their sponsors to use any photographs, videotapes or other recordings of myself and / or child that are made during the course of this event.
