2020 HIGHLIGHTS & EVENTS

- **Children's Garden:** Encouraging sensory play with musical instruments, fairy gardens, new plantings and outdoor kitchens.
- Memorial/Angel Garden: A shady seating area to relax and reflect with new plantings.
- **Seating Area:** Procurement of outdoor tables and chairs, as well as a shade sail to encourage and accommodate groups to utilize our open patio space.
- **High School Interns:** Implemented educational internship program for 2-3 students working 4 hour each week from July through October, watering, weeding, mulching and learning plant identification.
- **Food for Families in Need:** Our vertical, pollinator and teaching gardens all produced fresh organic vegetables, fruits and herbs that were continuously donated to Outreach at Our Lady of Fatima Church.
- Butterflies: 21 Butterfly Release events totaling over 1100 migrating monarchs at the new Children's Garden
- Collaborations with other local non-profits
- Volunteer garden workdays
- Wellness workshops
