I am happy to report my totals from 2023 for community outreach: Quilts 198, hats 107, chemo hats 49, knitted and crochet items 61, bears 232, NJCU developmental hearts 418, chemo pillows 144, burp cloths 116, and adult bibs 115.

This is tremendous and I thank you all for taking time to do so much for the community.

We have a new project. The infusion/chemo clinic at the hospital is offering patients a throw size covering to keep warm during their appointments.

They have requested 36x48 inches. They can be flannel on both sides OR Cotton on one side and a flannel backing. NO BATTING so they take less space in the cabinet at the hospital.

Since there is no batting you can do the bagging technique if you don't want to bind them. Then you can tie them OR quilt them OR use a stitch on your machine to tack them

They will be light weight but soft and warm. Thanks for all who want to participate


Perhaps one or two members can work together on items; it more fun to sew with another person. Maybe each mini group can come up with ideas for their group members to make.
