

2025 Annual PQ Retreat

The 2025 PQ Retreat will be held at the Hampton Inn, 4017 Tampa Road, Oldsmar beginning at noon Thursday May 29, 2025 to Sunday June 1, 2025 at 3:00 pm.

The cost of the retreat will remain the same at \$130.00. A block of rooms has been reserved at the hotel and a separate link will be emailed to members for reservations. Room rates are \$119.00/ night for 2 queen beds, and \$139.00/night for studio with 2 queen beds, these rates do not include tax or other hotel fees. All rooms include a microwave and small refrigerator.

There is free parking, complimentary continental breakfast daily from 6:00 am to 9:00 am, and coffee and tea is always available in the hotel lobby, bottled water will be provided by the guild. The hotel also features free Wi-Fi, an outdoor pool, fitness center, and business center. Meals are on your own with plenty of nearby restaurants in a wide variety of price ranges.

PQ Retreat registration will begin in September and a \$50.00 deposit will secure your spot. The “sewing room” will accommodate 36 participants, so register early to secure your spot. Final payment will be due by the May PQ Meeting (May 15, 2025).

I am pleased to be your retreat chairperson again this year and looking forward to another great time sewing with friends.


