

## **Brown Bag Challenge – Pat Holliday**

BROWN BAG 2025 wants your help!

The plan is to "flood" the infusion lab with donations. If you choose to participate, put approximately 1/2 yard of fabric in a bag and bring it to the June meeting. (No worries if you don't have a bag, I have extras). Bags will be recorded, numbered, and exchanged.

Add stash fabric to the fabric you received, choose a favorite quilt block (Villa Rosa is a source for great patterns) and make a quilt. Infusion lab quilts are two layers about 40" by 50"in size. This measurement is not exact, so anything goes! These quilts have flannel backs and are pillowcase finished and can be tied or machine tacked. The quilts are also given to nursing mothers for cover-up so depending on your fabric that will work. Brown Bag hopes this will be a no stress project so have fun with it. Thanks
