
Mesh drain bags used for showering after surgery

Each bag holds two drains.

Cut mesh material 7 ½ inches x 13 inches and hold in half lengthwise.

Using a ½ inch seam, sew 1 inch down from the top. Skip an area about 1 inch and then sew the rest of the way down the seam.




Fold so that the seam is going down the middle of the bag and sew across the bottom.

Fold over the top of the bag about 1 inch to create the channel where the ribbon will go and sew all the way around.

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Cut ribbon 54 inches long, insert a safety pin to one end and thread it through the channel.

Tie the two ends of the ribbon together in a knot.



Fold down the top one inch and sew around the bag. You have created a casing
