UFO Challenge – Robin and Gretchen

The survey that was done last year indicated that members would like to have a UFO related activity that would motivate them to finish a few things in a fun way. Therefore, we are bringing back a UFO Challenge this year! This is always a fun way to work on your unfinished projects, and we hope to have many participating!

Here is how it will work:

1. Members sign up at the January meeting to indicate that they will be participating.
2. Between Jan and Feb Meetings compile a list of 9 projects to complete in 2026, number them 1-9. Projects don't have to be a quilt but sb quilt or sewing related.
3. Bring a copy of the list to the Feb Meeting. (Email to Robin VanScoy if you are unable to attend the Feb Meeting)
4. Each month starting in Feb we will pull a number. You work on the project that corresponds to that number.
5. Bring the finished item to the next meeting. Show it, we check it off your list and your name goes in the UFO jar for a chance to win 1 of 2 great prizes.
It is ok to finish and show from a previous month, YOU Got it DONE, show it off!
The idea is to work toward finishing the project in a month, if you don't it's ok, at least you worked on it.
6. We will pull the names of the winners at the Dec Gathering and vote to see if we want to do a similar process and challenge in 2027. 10 Projects if a new list is created and brought to the Jan meeting.
