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## Dumpster for use by townhome residents only.

Please note there are some restrictions with the dumpster. Bottom line, please be reasonable in what you place in the dumpster. Before dumping, please explore options to recycle, repurpose or donate items instead of throwing them away. Consider utilizing the Winter Hill neighbors listserv, our local Facebook Buy Nothing group, or Freecycle. Electronic recycling is also available at Staples or at eAssets Solutions on Maple Ave. Safely dispose of hazardous items at designated dropoff areas (searchable online).

Here are the minimal guidelines, but please err on the side of caution:

- 1. Do not dump prohibited items:
- TIRES
- SOFAS
- MATTRESSES & BOX SPRINGS
- PAINT
- CHEMICALS
- SOLVENTS OF ANY KIND
- OIL AND ANTIFREEZE
- FUELS
- FIRES, SMOULDERING MATERIALS, OR ASHES
- HERBICIDES AND PESTICIDES
- ASBESTOS
- RADIOACTIVE FLAMMABLE OR IGNITABLE
- EXPLOSIVES

- BIO-MEDICAL WASTE
- LIQUID WASTES
- FREON
- REFRIGERATORS OR FREON APPLIANCES
- RAILROAD TIES
- CAR BATTERIES OR OTHER BATTERIES
- CELL PHONES, COMPUTERS, OR ELECTRONICS
- AEROSOL CANS
- LIVE OR DEAD ANIMALS
- PROPANE TANKS AND FIRE EXTINGUISHERS
- TOXIC OR HAZARDOUS MATERIAL (AS DEFINED BY RCRA IN 40 CFR 261)
- 2. The dumpster cannot be removed if anything is sticking above the top rim. Space is first come first served.
- 3. Be reasonable with your additions. This is a community dumpster and not a personal receptacle for construction projects or large scale moving clean out, etc.
- 4. Please use the dumpster only between <u>7am and 9pm</u> to be respectful of the surrounding neighbors.
- 5. Clean up after yourself. Do not leave items or a mess outside of the dumpster for others to clean up.
- 6. Be respectful to the board and other residents. While the dumpster is paid for by our HOA dues, that does not give anyone cart blanche to treat others poorly.
- 7. In case of heavy rain, the dumpster will need to be covered. We are limited in how many tons of junk we can put in the dumpster, without incurring extra costs, and rainwater will add significantly to that amount.
