Winter Hill Parking FAQs

Q. What is the max parking limit for the unreserved spots?

A. Three days for the same vehicle.

Q. What do I do if I have two cars and I will be out of town for more than three days? A. Street parking is available for

second vehicles. You will need a Zone 1 sticker or Overnight Parking booklet.

Q. Where can my guests park? A. Guests can only park in your reserved spot or on the street with the appropriate overnight tag.
