







Product Description



These US-made brushed aluminum plates are fitted with genuine Neutrik[®] XLR connectors firmly machine riveted into place, and are designed to fit standard US single-gang electrical boxes. For greater security, add your own tamper-proof (6-32) mounting screws. Google it; there are many; including Leviton.

Note that the XLR gender used in intercom is the reverse of that normally used in audio applications to avoid the voltage present on an intercom circuit from being accidentally applied to a microphone.





YC-2: for recreating loop-thru capability on BP1S, BP2 & BP15



L1906: Plug into 3-pin female cable end to create new isolated circuit.

BA905: Pass operating current without signal. E.G: Add 2nd power supply.



YC-6: for converting 1 six-pin male XLR to 2 three-pin female. XLRs. (AD913)

This 4-piece custom ordered combination, used to extend a BP1SL or BP2 over a long distance, is an example of the many special pieces we can provide.
