BEFORE THAT RAY FRONTED THE HARD ROCK BAND STILTSKIN WITH WHOM HE HAD AN INTERNATIONAL NUMBER 1 HIT, 'THE MINDS EYE'. IN BETWEEN WORKING WITH GENESIS RAY IS PLANNING TO DO AN ALBUM WITH HIS BAND OF SEVEN YEARS, 'CUT'.


...WAS BORN...47 YEARS AGO IN EAST HOATHLY SUSSEX UNDER THE SIGN OF ARIES
