I also have to say that while I've been proud of all my


I also have to say that while I've been proud of all my different line-ups I feel this band is the most complete group I've ever had. I hope you agree.


As for the songs, there'll be the old ones and the new ones, some having changed a little, some not. One thing is for certain - we'll be having fun, and we hope you will too.


