**ATTENTION EXHIBITORS**

X-pens will not be allowed in the building. **PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOGS**

Dogs must be removed from the Trial site immediately following the conclusion of the judging every night. No dogs may be left in building overnight. There will be no space for un-entered dogs

ALL DOGS PRESENT MUST BE HELD ON LEASH BY THE HANDLER OR CONFINED TO THEIR CRATES except when being judged. Dogs may not be on Flexi-Leads or long leads while in the building. No prong collars.

EXHIBITORS SHOULD FOLLOW THEIR VETERINARIAN'S recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. **CANINE INFLUENZA VACCINE STRONGLY SUGGESTED**
