

This continuing project to develop the 30+ acre woodland property near Whiteville donated to Wildlife Action by Earl and Dot Helms will provide our community with an educational/recreational facility for our Wildlife Action youth programs, and in addition, serves as a valuable resource available to other groups, organizations and the people of our community. We have a long tradition of working closely with and making our facilities available to Scouts, 4-H, church groups, civic groups and other community organizations. The preserve will include handicap-accessible nature trails, camping and picnic areas, wildlife feeding and observation stations and outdoor classrooms and meeting areas.

These principles are summarized in Wildlife Action's *Five Point Law: Preservation, Conservation, Education, Sportsmanship and Fellowship*, and our motto "*Local Folks Solving Local Problems*" exemplifies our focus on the family and local community.
