

Be aware of the SLOW processing times for US Visas at the American Embassy in Manila

TN Visa and the US-**Mexico-Canada Trade** Agreement allows citizens of Canada and Mexico who work in certain professions to work in the US.





L1 Visa (Intracompany Company Transferee and Two Categories:

L-1A (Executives and Managers), and

L-1B (Intracompany specialized knowledge professional) Parent Company, Subsidiary or Affiliate

J-1 Visa

Beware of the return to the home country for two years unless you obtain a waiver





F-1 Visa

Take advantage of the OPT which is good for one year and then you may be back to Square One

F-1 Vis

Even better take advantage of the STEM MBA graduate with an OPT of three years and you have more chances of getting out of Square One





E-1 Treaty Trader Visa

Temporary Only-Watch out for the kids when they turn 21

E-2 Treaty Investor Visa

Temporary Only -Watch out for the kids when they turn **21**





EB 5 Investor Green Card Program

Requires \$\$\$\$ must hire 10 US residents within 2 years and survive more than 5 years

Accountants have the edge over lawyers when setting up a non-profit entity including non-profit research organizations





Having the magic words in your Articles of Incorporation can get you pass the H-1B quota and now your non-profit A with ² organization becomes an H-1B cap-exempt entity.

Say goodbye to the H-1B Lottery!



THE MAGIC WORDS:

The Corporation is organized primarily to conduct and promote comprehensive basic and or applied research of contemporary education issues, which include, but are not limited to, perspectives from information technology, data analysis, government, anthropology, law, history, fine arts, medicine, science, economics, commerce and philosophy. This includes, making recommendations regarding related policy impacts that would be useful to the individual and beneficial to the community.



Department of the Treasury Internal Revenue Service The IRS Form 1023 is an exercise in accounting and creating the proposed research areas of your organization.

Once you get pass the labor certification, bachelor's degree equivalency and related work experience you just have to prove that your non-profit organization can pay for employee salaries





The caveat: Have a web-site of your research organization flushed with research or white papers

Staff writes one threeto-five-page white paper every six month about their practical work experience (applied research)





Can staff up and plan anytime of the year to get an H-1 visa decision within **FIFTEEN** working days of submission via PREMIUM **PROCESSING** with the **USCIS?**

H-1B is good for two three-year periods or six years and can be converted into a green card.
