CPA REVIEW SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA:

- 1. Be a member of NCPACA chapter and be involved in the organization's activities.
- 2. Be a Philippines resident.
- 3. 18 years of age or older.
- 4. Be an accounting professional or student who recently graduated with a baccalaureate degree and not currently enrolled in any CPA Exam Review at the time of scholarship notification.
- 5. Meet your state requirements to sit for the CPA Exam at the time of financial assistance notification.
- 6. If a recent college graduate, submit copies of transcripts from any colleges attended.
- 7. Current resume that includes any internships (paid or unpaid), jobs, awards, volunteer positions.
- 8. Submit a letter of recommendation from an employer/manager, professor, mentor, community leader or clergy member along with your application.
- 9. Through a personal statement, demonstrate (1) a financial need in preparing for the CPA Exam, (2) the traits important to become a successful CPA and (3) plans to successfully pass the CPA exams.
- 10. As this is a financial assistance where the applicant demonstrates a need in preparing for the CPA review, it is not valid for applicants that are employed by or have accepted a position at an employer that offers a CPA review reimbursement of equal or greater value.
- 11. Scholarship is non-transferable.
- 12. Application is open only for FIRST time examination applicants.
- 13. Provide a copy of the official exam results from Board of Accountancy, whether Pass or Fail, for tracking purposes.
