Information for Schools:

- 1) Presentations should be 1.5 hours and interactive/collaborative in nature.
- 2) Student presenters are encouraged and schools with them will be given preference for selection. Schools bringing students will be given a \$1000 stipend for travel.
- 3) Schools must commit to participate in a roundtable at the end of each conference day to answer questions or facilitate further discussion.
- 4) Presenting schools must commit to stay for both days of the conference. Presentations will be scheduled to coincide with conference themes. REQUESTS FOR SPECIFIC DAYS AND TIMES CANNOT BE HONORED.
- 5) Schools will receive two waived adult registrations and up to three free student registrations. All other members of the school must register for the conference. Up to three students will be eligible for complimentary registrations from 3-7 students, the conference fee will be 50% of the regular "Early Bird" fee.
- 6) Presenters agree to having presentations recorded and streamed to off site participants ONLY on the dates of the conference. Rights pass to The EdExcellence Group, LLC for conference dates only.

- 7) This is a conference for and about practitioners. Consultants or others selling services may not be chosen.
- 8) There will be a maximum of two complimentary registrations for presenters.
- 9) School visits are not included in the presenter registrations. They are an extra, non-waived fee and must be paid for separately.
- 10) Basic technology will be provided: projector, screen, house sound tap.
- 11) Any other technology needs and presentation materials must be furnished by the presenter.
- 12) Proposal notifications will be sent by October 1, 2019. School accepted MUST confirm their participation by October 30, 2019. Schools not confirming participation are subject to removal from the program.
- 13) Acceptance confirmation commits the school to presenting and registering for the conference.
- 14) Final program descriptions are due by December 1, 2019. If there is no response to our request for these, schools may be removed from the program
- 15) All presentation materials must be uploaded to the conference website by 01/20/2020 so that they may be made available online for all conference attendees.
- 16) Conference sponsors reserve the right to cancel the conference within 30 days of conference dates for lack of proposals or minimum threshold of participants.
