A lawyer with Legal Aid of Western Ohio well be here on the 2nd Thursday of the month. Appointments are 30 minutes each. This is a free service.

Most of the cases they can handle for seniors are the following: drafting a will/financial power of attorney, living will, healthcare power of attorney; collection defense/bankruptcy; landlord-tenant issues; simple probate issues; and avoiding probate advise (drafting a transfer on death for a house) We are now taking appointments for September 11th from 9:00 a.m.-12:30 p.m. Appointments are required and can be made by calling 419-691-2254 ext. 207.

TRANSPORTATION COST

Due to the large influx of transportations and unforeseen budget cuts, there are several changes to self-pay transportation (medical, shopping) that will begin May 1, 2025.

- All self-pay transportation will have a \$20 cost per transportation.
- Everyone is limited to (4) non-medical transportations per month.
- Each transportation is limited to (1) stop and then home.
- Payment is due to the drivers the day of service if paying with cash or check. If using a card, please have the driver call in to Derek and payment will be taken over the phone.
- If you are having a procedure that requires driver to stay, you must schedule a minimum of 30 days prior. We must know approximate length of appt. There is an additional \$30 charge for these trips as the driver will be on the clock the entire time.




