





When I was One,

We are excited to announce that 'Endless Pleasure' will feature a world premiere performance of a song cycle by it's composer Tristan Entwistle. Titled 'Songs from Now We Are Six,' this piece is a musical interpretation of ten poems from A.A. Milne's collection, Now We Are Six.





So I think I'll be six now for ever and ever.

Tristan completed his Master of Music Studies (Opera Performance) at the Sydney Conservatorium. He has performed for Opera Australia as a chorister since 2017.

His opera/operetta roles include Enrico (Lucia di Lammermoor), Marcello (La Bohéme), Silvio (Pagliacci), Germont (La Traviata), Escamillo (Carmen), Figaro (Il Barbiere di Siviglia), Guglielmo (Così fan tutte), Papageno (Die Zauberflöte), Figaro and Il Conte (Le Nozze di Figaro), Leporello (Don Giovanni), Edmund Bertram (Mansfield Park), Elder McLean (Susannah), Dr Falke (Die Fledermaus), Giove (La Calisto), the Drunken Poet (The Fairy Queen), the Pirate King (The Pirates of Penzance), and Giuseppe (The Gondoliers).

Tristan was a finalist in the 2017 German Australian Opera Grant, in the 2018 IFAC Handa Australian Singing Competition ("The Mathy"), and in the 2019 Joan Carden award.
