
What is American Heritage Girls??



AHG STATEMENT OF FAITH



All Charter Organizations and AHG Adult members are required to agree and live by AHG's Statement of Faith. This alignment is acknowledged annually as part of the registration and Charter Renewal process.



American Heritage Girls is a Christ-centered leadership and character development ministry. The following Statement of Faith applies to all American Heritage Girls' Charter Organizations and Adult Members.

"We believe that there is one Triune God-Father; Jesus Christ, His one and only Son; and the Holy Spirit-Creator of the universe and eternally existent. We believe the Holy Scriptures (Old and New Testaments) to be the inspired and authoritative Word of God. - *Registration is open until September 30th 2026*
(Done on AHG Family under each girls name. If you need help please see a board member)

- *\$6 - first girl member*
- *\$4 - each additional girl member.*

(Cost covers administrative fees with AHG, Patches are sold separately and added to their awards)

- *Girls are expected to communicate with their pen pal at least once a month from October 2026-September 2027*
- *All program levels can participate!*
- *Each girl receives a pen pal from a troop in a different state at the same program level.*
- *Communication can be regular mail, email, or both.*

Who can join?

All biological girls of any color, race, national origin and socioeconomic status who agree to live according to the standards of the AHG Oath and the AHG Creed are invited to be members of American Heritage Girls.

Do I have to be a member of a church?

No, you are not required

Can I stay in the building during the meeting?

To adhere to AHG policy, only registered AHG members are allowed in the building during troop meetings.

How do we order uniforms?

All uniforms should be ordered through the AHG store online and should be ordered during our troops registration night.
You can also order additional items individually.

Volunteering



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We will have multiple opportunities for volunteering.

Community Service is one portion of the AHG program. Community service will enlighten girls to the needs of those around them, help girls discover ways to meet those needs, and teach girls compassion. The ultimate goal is having girls with humble, servant's hearts. A humble servant's heart motivates an outward focus to follow Christ's example. Service is freely giving of your time, your talents, and your hard work for someone else's benefit without expecting anything in return.

- Pathfinder: 1 bead per service project
- Tenderheart: 1 blue star per 5 service hours
- Explorer: 1 red star per 10 service hours
- Pioneer: 1 white star per 15 service hours
- Patriot: 1 gold star per 20 service hours

Volunteering

Girls are required to volunteer a few hours of their time each year to complete service stars and level awards.

We will provide ample opportunity to acquire these hours throughout the year.

Fundraising

We will have at least two fundraisers during the year.

What types of fundraising will the girls do?
And why??

Fall Fundraiser: Pay a Day Calendar.

Spring Fundraiser: Tidal Wave Car wash tickets

The Troop fundraisers go directly towards the girls and their activities, ceremonies, etc.

Fundraising is MANDATORY. Buy out is \$100 per girl, per fundraiser.

Fundraising Policy

Fundraising is an essential activity for the success of a Troop. Funds earned support the entire Troop Budget, allowing for girls in the Troop to raise monies toward Troop incentives (such as trips or activities to be conducted by the Troop), and providing funding for the AHG Program Support Fee obligation so as not to provide additional burden on family expenses. Therefore, each American Heritage Girl Member is expected to participate. Participation in fundraising provides an intrinsic value to each Girl Member. She will develop her leadership skills and marketing experience as well as life skills development. PARTICIPATION FOR EVERY AGE GROUP IS MANDATORY, THERE IS A \$100 PER GIRL BUYOUT/ DIFFERENCE IF THE GOAL IS NOT MET. \$250 3+ SISTER CAP.

Girls who DO NOT meet the minimum sales toward the fundraising effort will be responsible for paying additional expenses such as camping fees, leadership events, etc. When an incentive is offered for fundraisers, no exchanges, modifications, or special requests will be allowed.

At least two registered adults (unrelated) are to be present at all troop meetings, trips, and activities to ensure the safety and well being of all involved. In addition to two-deep leadership, AHG also mandates specific girl-to-adult ratios for different age groups, which must be maintained during all activities.

TWO DEEP LEADERSHIP



At least two girls (buddy) are to go together EVERYWHERE at all troop meetings, trips, and activities to ensure their safety and well being. You may also choose to pick a truddy. Three girls are to go together. Girls are NEVER to be alone with an adult or by themselves for any reason. PERIOD.

BUDDY & TRUDDY



During meetings, activities, or events, Adults must use the main restroom. Please reserve the children's restrooms for the girls. Girls must have a buddy or truddy! Absolutley no exceptions.

RESTROOM/WATER BREAKS



BINDERS, SNACKS, & PHOTOGRAPHY

Binders will normally be placed on the sign in table before meetings. At the end of the night, please return your unit binder to the table.

Feel free to use the supplies in the supplies closet. (It's the red and black cabinet)

Snacks.. Please be aware of your units allergies. When bringing in a snack, we dont want anyone to feel left out. We also don't want any of the girls to have an allergic reaction.

Please be mindful when taking pictures. Some girls may not have a media release. You absolutely may not post pictures on social media unless you have prior permission from the parents of the photographed girls AND they have a media release signed.

First Aid/CPR/AED Certifications

Are you interested in becoming a safety lead?

Being First Aid/CPR/AED certified is essential for anyone working with children. Kids are especially vulnerable to medical emergencies such as choking, allergic reactions, asthma attacks, and falls, making it critical to respond quickly and effectively. Certification equips individuals with the skills and confidence to take immediate action—often making the difference between life and death—while waiting for emergency services to arrive. It also builds trust with parents and employers, demonstrating a strong commitment to safety and preparedness.



If you are interested in taking a First Aid/CPR/AED class, Please see Brandi Coffee (Charter Representative).

Classes are offered at cost only to AHG volunteers. Certification is good for 2 years after the skills session is completed.

You must have an in-person skills session to be a safety lead.
