

"This book is more than about moving," said Beale. "In today's world it's difficult for children and all they have to deal with. I hope the book will help them cope with the changes happening in their lives."

Beale's childhood was filled with adventures that captured her imagination in each new home. She continued her passion for adventure while raising her two daughters and working as a costume designer for local theaters. Now she is channeling her sense of fun and her youthful spirit into her children's stories. *The Adventures of Molly & Ollie: Moving Day* is the first book in the Molly & Ollie series.
