

## Body/Soul/Spirit Scriptures

<sup>1</sup>I Thessalonians 5:23 “May God himself, the God of peace, sanctify you through and through. May your whole spirit, soul and body be kept blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.”

<sup>2</sup>John 14:16-17 “And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another advocate to help you and be with you forever—the Spirit of truth. The world cannot accept him, because it neither sees him nor knows him. But you know him, for he lives with you and will be in you.”

<sup>3</sup>I Corinthians 6:19-20 “Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own; you were bought at a price. Therefore honor God with your bodies.”

<sup>4</sup>Romans 6:3,4,6,7 “Don’t you know that all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life. For we know that our old self was crucified with him so that the body ruled by sin might be done away with that we should no longer be slaves to sin – because anyone who has died has been set free from sin.”

<sup>5</sup>II Corinthians 5:17 “Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!”

<sup>6</sup>Galatians 4:6 Because you are his sons, God sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, the Spirit who calls out, “*Abba*, Father.”

<sup>7</sup>Ephesians 4:22-24 “You were taught, with regard to your former way of life, to put off your old self, which is being corrupted by its deceitful desires; to be made new in the attitude of your minds; and to put on the new self, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness.”

<sup>8</sup>II Corinthians 5:21 “God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.”

<sup>9</sup>Hebrews 13:12 “And so Jesus also suffered outside the city gate to make the people holy through his own blood.”

<sup>10</sup>Hebrews 10:14 “For by one sacrifice he has made perfect forever those who are being made holy.”

<sup>11</sup>Hebrews 5:13-14 “Anyone who lives on milk, being still an infant, is not acquainted with the teaching about righteousness. But solid food is for the mature, who by constant use have trained themselves to distinguish good from evil.”

<sup>12</sup>Ephesians 1:13-14 “When you believed, you were marked in him with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit, who is a deposit guaranteeing our inheritance.”

<sup>13</sup>I John 3:8-9 “The one who does what is sinful is of the devil, because the devil has been sinning from the beginning. The reason the Son of God appeared was to destroy the devil’s work. No one who is born of God will continue to sin, because God’s seed remains in them; they cannot go on sinning, because they have been born of God.”

<sup>14</sup>Hebrews 9:14 “How much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without blemish to God, purify our conscience from dead works to serve the living God.”

<sup>15</sup>James 1:23-25 “Anyone who listens to the word but does not do what it says is like someone who looks at his face in a mirror and, after looking at himself, goes away and immediately forgets what he looks like. But whoever looks intently into the perfect law that gives freedom, and continues in it—not forgetting what they have heard, but doing it—they will be blessed in what they do.”

<sup>16</sup>John 10:27 “My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me.”

<sup>17</sup>I John 4:17 “This is how love is made complete among us so that we will have confidence on the day of judgment: In this world we are like Jesus.”

<sup>18</sup>I Corinthians 6:17 “But whoever is united with the Lord is one with him in spirit.”

<sup>19</sup>Psalms 103:1-2 “Praise the LORD, my soul; all my inmost being, praise his holy name. Praise the LORD, my soul, and forget not all his benefits.”

<sup>20</sup>Romans 5:5 “And hope does not put us to shame, because God’s love has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit, who has been given to us.”

<sup>21</sup>Ephesians 2:1-2 “As for you, you were dead in your transgressions and sins, in which you used to live when you followed the ways of this world and of the ruler of the kingdom of the air, the spirit who is now at work in those who are disobedient.”

<sup>22</sup>II Timothy 1:7 “For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.”

<sup>23</sup>I John 4:18 “There is no fear in love. But perfect love drives out fear.”

<sup>24</sup>Galatians 2:20 “I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.”

<sup>25</sup>Galatians 5:16-17 “So I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh. For the flesh desires what is contrary to the Spirit, and the Spirit what is contrary to the flesh. They are in conflict with each other, so that you are not to do whatever you want.”

<sup>26</sup>I Corinthians 2:16 “But we have the mind of Christ.”

<sup>27</sup>II Peter 1:3 “His divine power has given us everything we need for a godly life through our knowledge of him who called us by his own glory and goodness.”

<sup>28</sup>Romans 12:2 “Do not be conformed to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind.”

<sup>29</sup>James 4:7 “Submit yourselves, then, to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.”

<sup>30</sup>John 14:6 “Jesus answered, ‘I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.’”

<sup>31</sup>Colossians 2:9-10 “For in Christ all the fullness of the Deity lives in bodily form, and in Christ you have been brought to fullness.”

<sup>32</sup>Proverbs 3:5-6 “Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make your paths straight.”

<sup>33</sup>II Corinthians 10:5 “We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ.”

<sup>34</sup>Philippians 4:4 “Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice!”

<sup>35</sup>Philippians 4:6 “Be anxious for nothing.”

<sup>36</sup>Psalms 34:1 “I will extol the LORD at all times; his praise will always be on my lips.”

<sup>37</sup>Galatians 5:22 “But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control.”

<sup>38</sup>John 15:16 “You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you so that you might go and bear fruit—fruit that will last—and so that whatever you ask in my name the Father will give you.”

<sup>39</sup>I Peter 5:7 “Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you.”

<sup>40</sup>Philippians 4:19 “And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus.”

<sup>41</sup>Isaiah 41:10 “So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.”

<sup>42</sup>Ephesians 2:8 “Your faith is not of your selves, it is a gift of God.”

<sup>43</sup>II Corinthians 5:7 “For we live by faith, not by sight.”

<sup>44</sup>Hebrews 12:1b-2a “And let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us, fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith.”

<sup>45</sup>Isaiah 26: 3 “You will keep in perfect peace those whose minds are steadfast, because they trust in you.”

<sup>46</sup>John 16:33 “I have told you these things, so that in me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world.”

<sup>47</sup>Romans 14:17 “For the kingdom of God is not a matter of eating and drinking, but of righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.”

<sup>48</sup>Romans 3:23 “For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.”

<sup>49</sup>Matthew 28:18 “All authority has been given to me. Therefore go and make disciples.”
