How can I take a flight?

Flights are open to all applicants regardless of race, age, color, religion, national origin, handicap, or medical condition. Most attendees are members of existing organizations, but you can also contact us via our website.

Can I take classes and learn to fly?

We have plans to offer lessons once we own our glider. Potential students are screened by flight instructors certified by the Federal Aviation Administration and receive ground instruction using FAA-approved curricula.

How are we funded?

Freedom's Wings Arizona relies on the generous contributions of its members and associates, both private and corporate. Each flight costs over one hundred dollars, so your donation can give a flight to a person with a disability.



How long are the flights?

Our flights are typically 15 to 20 minutes long, from a gentle ride to a rollercoaster.
