Math Skill

Counting 0-5

By the time your little one finishes kindergarten she/he will need to count to 100. Start small and increase numbers once your child has mastered what you have practiced with them.

Literacy Skill

Children should be able to identify the letters in their first and last name. Practice spelling your child's first and last name this week. If you point to a letter and they can name it for you move on to the next letter. Before you know it they will know all the letters in their name.
