The community came together to find Dom a new place to call home





A MOM'S LAST WISH

Our hearts dropped when we spoke with a Mom who was at the end of her battle with cancer. She wanted to give her kids new bikes as her last gift to them. She gave us the exact bikes she wanted. Inventory was extremely slim for the holiday season due to the pandemic and the increase in bike riding as an outdoor activity and an excuse to get outside. Our family spent the holiday shopping season driving from one Target to the next at midnight each night. That is when they restocked their bikes. We finally found the exact bikes the Mother wanted. Unexpectedly, weeks before Christmas, we received a call that we needed to deliver the bikes as soon as possible due to the mother's decreasing health. The family would be celebrating an early Christmas. Dom and his Mom drove the bikes to the family home and left them on the front porch that night.

The bikes were the last gift Mom gave her children before passing just a few days later.

A COMMUNITY UNDER WATER

When the streets of Phoenixville started flooding from Hurricane Ida just before Labor Day weekend of 2021, five homeless people opted to chain their bikes to a tree in hopes that the rising Schuylkill River and current would not take them away. When they returned a few days later, the bikes were gone!

Dom understood how a bike can be one person's whole world. He wanted to help! Dom hand-selected a bike for each individual, fixed and replaced some parts, and gave them each a good tune-up. He made sure that each homeless person had a trustworthy bike to replace the one that washed away.





All recipients of a gifted bike have the option to remain fully anonymous, even to the DFB team, by submitting a request online and having contactless pickup and dropoff.

FIGHTING ADDICTION

A few months after DFB was approved as an official 501(c)(3) non-profit, a woman reached out on social media to Dom after she heard about the organization from a friend and the great things Dom was doing for the community. The woman was reaching out to nominate her nephew who had been struggling with addiction and was working on climbing out of what she described as "his black hole." He was open about his recovery journey and was able to get a job but had no money to buy a car or get insurance.

Dom picked out a mountain bike from his inventory of donated bikes, made some repairs, washed it up, and left it out for the Aunt to pick up on a Sunday. On Monday, the young man started a new job and he rode to and from work on his new bicycle (pictured left). The woman was so appreciative she made a donation of some raffle baskets to a DFB FUN-draiser so the cycle of gifting continue!d



DOM GOES GLOBAL

Through his studies in middle school, Dom started to recognize that children (and even some adults) all over the world are in need of access to bikes. Transportation is key in small villages. Dom met Ibrahim, who was coordinating a cargo shipment to a village in Sierra Leone, West Africa during the spring of 2023. Dom instantly knew he wanted to donate bikes and send a few of his custom DFB bikes, along with a few others that were donated to DFB across the word to help those in West Africa!

Dom and the Board of Directors all agreed that with a gifted DFB bike comes power, freedom, mobility, and positive change.

In addition to the 36 bikes Dom sent to West Africa in the spring, Dom intends to send another 39 bikes by the end of 2023. Sending a total of 75 bikes in the 2023 calendar year spanning over two fiscal years.






