CHYS hosted the Florida Commodores Association (FCA) event on July 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup>. The Commodores in attendance were extremely complementary about our Club. The Filet and Lobster dinner Saturday evening was fabulous. This event is being followed up with the Florida Council of Yacht Clubs meeting on the weekend of September 11th. The Florida Council of Yacht Clubs (FCYC) is comprised of thirty-six 501(c)(7) yacht and sailing clubs throughout Florida, located from the Panhandle to the Florida Keys. This organization is dedicated to encouraging the sport of yachting and general club activities while promoting beneficial legislation and safety afloat. The major benefit of CHYC's membership in FCYC is that our Club's Full Members are provided one -night complementary dockage (you are charged for electricity) several times each year. You have access to the host Club's facilities. Your Host Club "Dining Experience" bill is sent to CHYC for payment. CHYC pays the host club, then bills you for your stay at the member club. If you have the time, are a Full CHYC Member and have access to a "proper yacht" (sail or power boat capable of living aboard), you could cruise Florida for several months without paying for dockage (you will have to pay your pass-through meal and electricity bill to CHYC).

Please consider making reservations for dinner (and the Sundowner Ceremony) with our FCYC guests the weekend of September 11<sup>th</sup>. This will be a memorable event.

Our staff and volunteers are sprucing up the Club as I am writing this report. The color scheme (Blue Trim & Ivory Walls) in the main entry/hallway and Ballroom is the same as the back hallway (the hall from the Wheel Room to the Kitchen). # Dear Friends of Education,

For over 25 years the Charlotte County Take Stock in Children program has focused on ensuring that deserving low income students graduate from high school and are prepared for their future learning and career goals. This success is made possible by an innovative multi-year program model of college readiness services, meeting regularly with a mentor, and scholarships. These things combine to create life changing experiences for our students.

Would you know, or be able to recommend, any adults that may have an interest in volunteering as a mentor for our program? We are looking for positive role models for the students we serve.

We're proud of our student's success and have an outstanding record of accomplishment with the students that enter our program. We continue to add new students every year. On average 98% of our students graduate from high school. 96% enroll in college, and 70% go on to achieve a post-secondary degree.

Caring adult mentors are the key to our success and must be willing to meet with our students by volunteering about one hour per week. They are the backbone of our organization. There is of course an application and background check required prior to being "matched" to a student. Training is provided, but the most important qualification is a heart and willingness to help a young person in need.



# DRESS CODE DEFINITIONS


