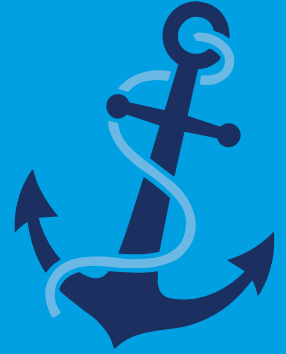

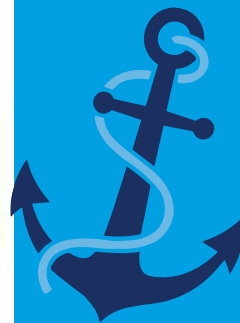

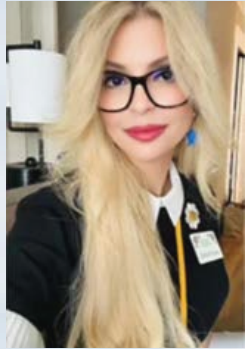

Staggered Summer Shutdown Schedule

To ensure our beautiful clubhouse and facilities remain in pristine condition, we have finalized our annual summer maintenance schedule. This year, our summer shutdown will last only one week, but we have strategically split it into two segments between July (4 days) and August (3 days). This approach allows us to execute deep cleaning.

Important Facility Shut Down Dates:

- Shutdown 1: Closed from Monday, July 27th, through Thursday, July 30th. The club will fully reopen for normal operations on Friday, July 31st.
- Shutdown 2: Closed from Sunday, August 23rd, through Tuesday, August 25th. The club will fully reopen for normal operations on Wednesday, August 26th.

By splitting our shutdown, we are intentionally reserving the second half of that traditional maintenance week. Should a hurricane threaten our coastline later this season, we will utilize those preserved operational days to absorb any mandatory emergency closures, thereby minimizing overall disruption to your membership access throughout the autumn.

Hurricane Preparedness & Marina Safety Mandates

With the official arrival of hurricane season, safeguarding our club infrastructure and our members' vessels in the marina is our absolute priority. We ask all slip renters and visiting boaters to immediately see the Club Manager to obtain this year's copy of Charlotte Harbor Yacht Club's Hurricane Plan, review, and execute all safety protocols contained within it. If you are not in the area, please email manager@charlotteharboryc.com to obtain a digital copy. During the week, we are working on posting a digital version on the membership portal of our website. Please understand that it is the member's responsibility, for those who have their vessel docked at CHYC, to ensure that the club management in the front office has a current copy of your watercraft insurance policy, valid registration, and updated emergency contact phone numbers on file. All preparations for your vessel must be completed well in advance of landfall in the event of a named storm.

A Gentle Reminder Regarding FCYC Reciprocal Visits

We love seeing our members take advantage of our wonderful Florida Council of Yacht Clubs (FCYC) reciprocal privileges! As a quick reminder, if you recently visited a participating club and don't see the charge reflected on your account statement, please let our front office know. Because reciprocal billing can occasionally experience a delay, it is still each member's responsibility to report these visits so we can process your payment in a timely manner. Keeping your account up to date ensures everything runs smoothly and prevents accidental past-due fees or membership holds.

Thank you for your cooperation, compliance, and shared commitment to maintaining the safety and excellence of the Charlotte Harbor Yacht Club. I look forward to seeing you all at our beautiful clubhouse.

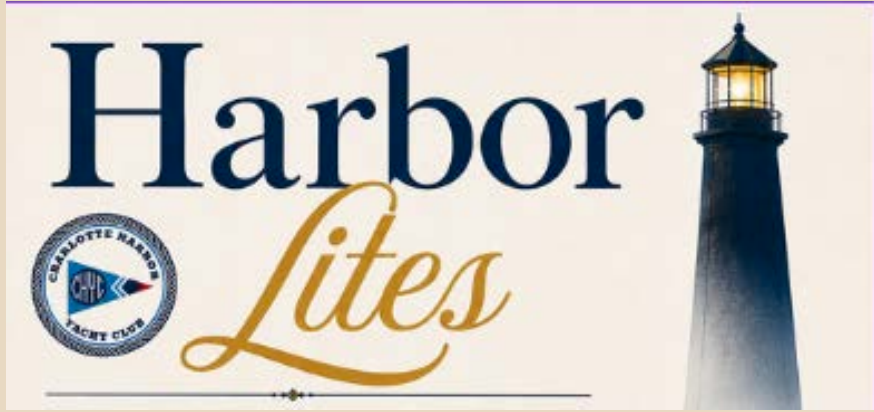

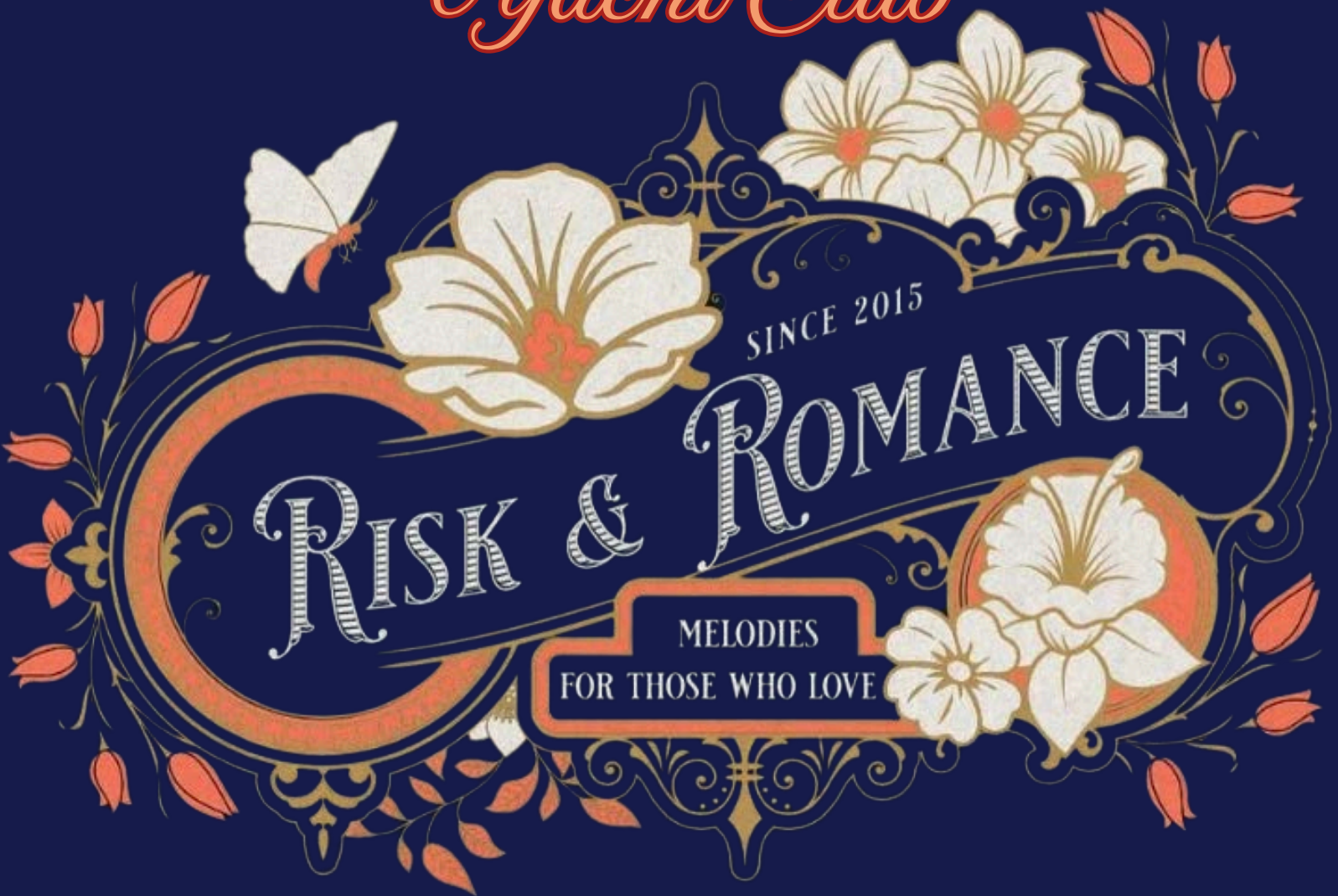

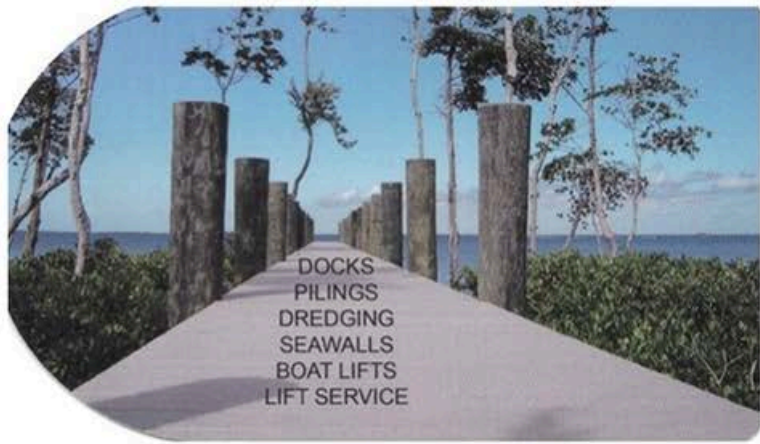

DRESS CODE DEFINITIONS

Jacket Required: Gentlemen wear suits or sports coat and trousers, dress shirt and tie (optional), turtleneck or dressy collarless shirt with sleeves. Ladies wear dresses or suits, long or short skirts, or dressy slacks and tops.

Casual: Gentlemen wear dressy slacks, collared shirt, turtleneck or dressy collarless shirt with sleeves. Ladies wear skirts, dressy slacks and tops. For Gentlemen and Ladies, no shorts, no torn or cutoff clothing. Dress denim is allowed.

Shorts Permitted: Gentlemen wear dressy slacks or appropriate length shorts, collared shirt, turtleneck or dressy collarless shirt with sleeves. Ladies wear skirts, dressy slacks or dressy shorts and tops. For Gentlemen and Ladies, no T-shirts, torn or cutoff clothing. Upscale denim is allowed.

Casual-Casual: Designated areas are the Ships Wheel and the Outside Deck the designated areas for men and women to wear athletic clothing to include, but not limited to, sport clothing, T-shirts and shorts. The Ships Wheel will permit this type of dress between the hours of 10 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Saturday. The Outside Deck will permit this type of dress from the Club opening until Club closing, unless there is a private function being held using the outside deck.

Please note: T-shirts are never permitted in the dining room.
