Welcome to the May 2025 edition of our Charlotte Harbor Yacht Club Depth Sounder! With the warm spring winds settling in and longer daylight hours, May is shaping up to be a phenomenal month for getting out on the water. From exciting destinations to on-the-water events and Club happenings, there's something for everyone to enjoy.

#### **A** Sailing Hot Spots of the Month **1.** Boca Grande Pass

Often called the gateway to the Gulf, Boca Grande Pass is a favorite for day cruisers and anglers alike. Tarpons are starting to run, and the clear Gulf waters are perfect for sailing or anchoring for a swim. Just watch out for the changing tides and the occasional shark sightings.

#### 2. Cayo Costa State Park

Accessible only by boat, Cayo Costa offers pristine beaches, hiking trails, and fantastic overnight anchoring. It's a must-visit in May before the summer crowds arrive. We often go on trips and raft up to this great location. Keep an eye out for our next scheduled raft ups.

#### 3. Punta Gorda Isles Canal System

For a more leisurely sail or motor cruise, the canals of PGI offer calm, protected waters and scenic homes. Ideal for new skippers or social raft -ups. Also, it is a great place to head to if the wind starts to pick up and you are in need of some quick sheltered water.

#### 4. Burnt Store Marina to Matlacha Island

Enjoy a half-day trip to Matlacha, a quirky island town with art galleries and waterside dining. The channel into Matlacha is narrow but well-marked - ideal for shallow-draft boats.







#### **DRESS CODE DEFINITIONS**

The Ships Wheel will permit this type of dress between the hours of 10 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Saturday. The Outside Deck will permit this type of dress from the Club opening until Club closing, unless there is a private function being held using the outside deck.
