#### *HARBORMASTERS*



Last month, we described in this column what the Harbormasters do in our club and invited male members to join our activities and the ROMEOS; an adjunct of the Harbormasters.

Now, a brief history of the Harbormasters in our Charlotte Harbor Yacht Club is necessary.

In late 1975 the Board of Directors wanted more active participation of its male members in activities. So, it created a "Men's Group" which would meet regularly once a month on a Saturday for lunch with a host a speaker. Sixty-four (64) men attended the first meeting on January 17, 1976, having a 'delicious' meal of soup and sandwich costing \$1.75. The Rear Commodore was appointed overseer of the "Men's Group".

The "Men's Group" was also given the task of "Landscaping and Beautification of the Grounds around the Club House, Basin and Parking Lots". A crew of 24 male club volunteers was established expending thousands of man hours in cleaning up, grading and planting hundreds of bushes, shrubs and trees. Fuel Servicing for boats was established through the purchases of "B" series debenture bonds ... and the "Men's Group" manned the pumps for several years dispensing fuels. For more than ten years until the late 1980'sthe "Men's Group" also did all of the lawn maintenance themselves.

Of course, most of the volunteer men at that time were much younger; in their late thirties and forties which is not the case now.

In 1992 the "Men's Group" was recognized as an official auxiliary group with rules andregulations in our bylaws and officially named "The Harbormasters" which is what we are known as today!

Several of us plan to call all the males in our club personally in the next few weeks to explain the mission of the Harbormasters and let you ask any questions you might have.

Our goal is to support our Yacht Club, raise funds for necessary projects, obtain new experiences thru host speakers and local day trips, ... and most of all have FUN together....

Wind Chaser took seventh overall and was happy to participate after a restoration that was less than one year. Previously, the Rhodes 19 had not seen the water for 25 plus years. They said they would be back in 2022 to carry the CHYC flag.





#### DRESS CODE DEFINITIONS


