
### **Monthly Members' Meetings**

Members continue to contact me and advise they have received text messages or e-mails, saying someone is busy and could you go out and buy some gift cards.



### **Getting Your Digital On!**

Have you been thinking about getting online and want to know

more about it? Maybe you have interest in sharing your art online? Or, maybe you're thinking about building your own website? Whether you are a newcomer or an experienced online

digital user, this workshop will be helpful to you. We'll have:

- Three live Zoom Workshops over the summer! June 13th, July 11th, and August 8th from 9:30am to 11:30am.
- All workshops will be recorded and can be listened to/repeated at any time.
- A private Facebook page will be set up for the use of all throughout the summer to engage with each other and for further instruction, questions, resources, and discussion with

the instructor.

**Topics Covered:** 

June 13th - Digital Media Overview - An overview of various

avenues of online media (zoom, social media, personal websites,

and 3rd party sales platforms, along with a discussion on the

safety concerns with an online presence.

July 11th - Social Media - We'll specifically be looking at

Facebook and Instagram. We'll also touch on Pinterest, YouTube, and LinkedIn.

August 8th – Personal Website – How to set up and create your

own personal website utilizing the GoDaddy platform.

GoDaddy

has a free website option. You can choose to upgrade to a paid

plan with more options if you wish. Each online class is 2 hours and will be held on Zoom. I'll show you how to work with Zoom at the beginning of each class. The Live Zoom Workshops and the Ongoing/Online Classroom

Package is \$45 for MEMBERS; \$60 for NON-MEMBERS.

Each class will be recorded. The link for each recording will be

emailed to the registrants and uploaded to our private Facebook

classroom page. If you miss a class or want to review it again, you can listen to the recording anytime at your convenience. There's no preparation for this class other than you will need

to

have an active Facebook profile account to be able to participate

in the online classroom. You can sign up and create a basic profile account with minimal information and no photos if you

prefer. This is not a requirement for the workshops! If you

have concerns and/or questions about this, let me know.
Once you are registered for the class, you'll receive an
invitation

link to our private FB classroom page and instructions on how to

access Zoom. Please note the classroom will not be open until June 10th

You can access the classroom and Zoom with your phone, pad, or computer.
