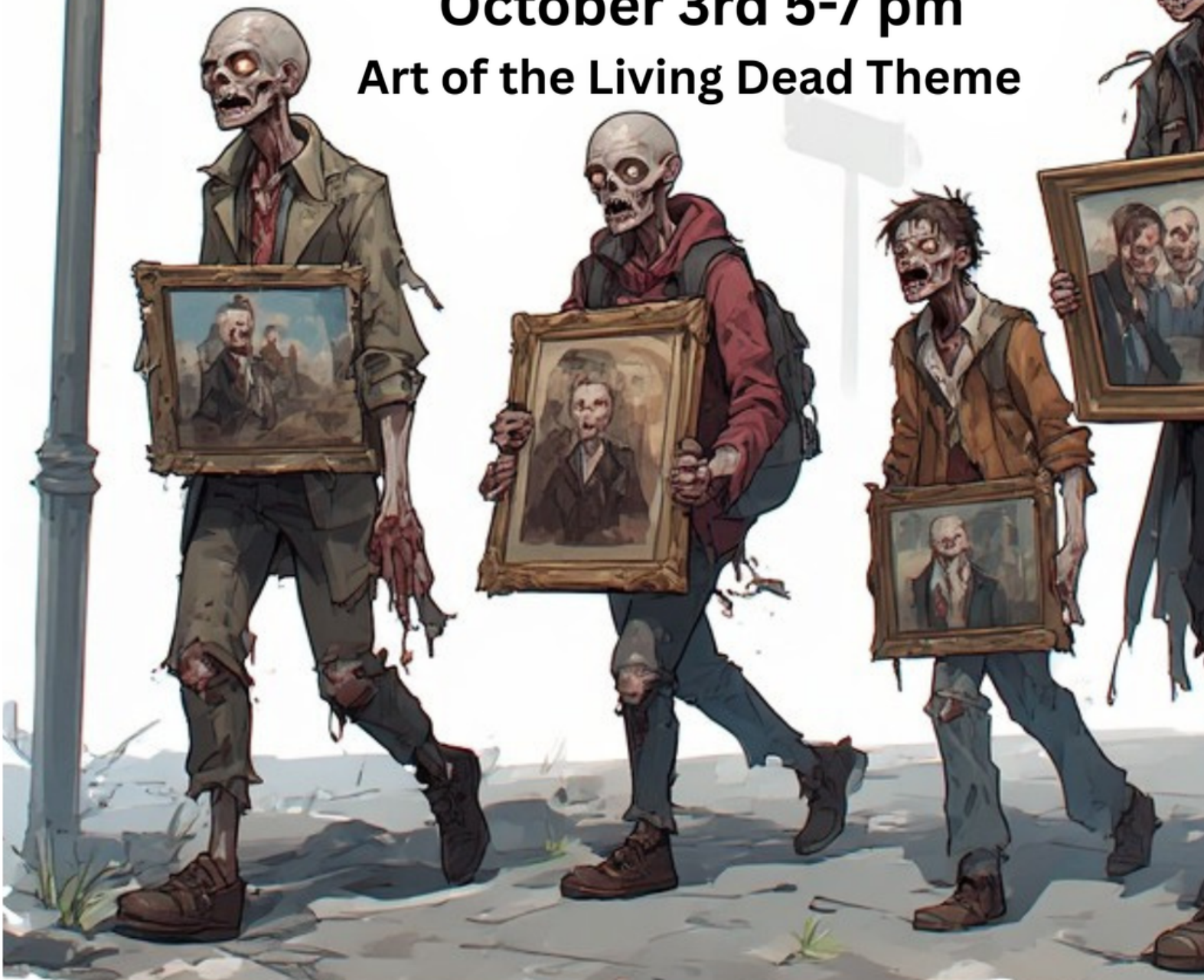

Joe currently lives between Decatur, Georgia and Lake City, South Carolina. He recently had a ten year retrospective exhibition at Georgia State Perimeter College in Clarkston, Georgia and a solo exhibition at Acline Studios in Lake City, SC where he also created the first crosswalk mural in the city for Artfields 2025.
