



SEACOAST ARTISTS GUILD ANNUAL FALL ART SHOW and SALE PROSPECTUS

The Seacoast Artists Guild Fall Art Show and Sale is open to all current Members of the Guild and to non-members as well.

The Registration Fee is:

\$30.00 for Seacoast Artist Guild Members

\$60.00 for Non-members

(Includes Membership in the Seacoast Artists Guild through October 1, 2026)

Acceptable forms of Art include Painting, Drawing, Graphics, Photography, Mixed Media, Fiber, Textile, Sculpture, Wood Carving and Original Ceramics. All work that is the sole original creation of the artist, completed within the past two years and not previously entered into a Seacoast Artists Guild Art Show may be submitted. Work created in a class or workshop where the instructor has had a hand in the completion of the work is not eligible.

ALL artwork entered in the show must be for sale!

The Guild requests a 20% commission on all art sold. Please price your work accordingly.

PRIZES WILL BE AWARDED FOR BEST IN SHOW, 2ND PLACE, 3RD PLACE, AND 10 HONORABLE MENTIONS.

DELIVERY OF ART – Sunday & Monday, August 31st and September 1st, 2025, 10:00 am to 6:00 pm *(If you have a conflict, please arrange to have another person deliver up your entries.)*

SHOW DATES & HOURS – The Show will run Wednesday, September 3rd, 2025, through Wednesday, September 17th, 2025.

AWARDS RECEPTION – Saturday, September 6th - 5:00 pm to 7:00 pm

ART PICKUP – Thursday, September 18th, 2025, 10:00 am to 6:00 pm. **ONE DAY ONLY!**
(If you have a conflict, please arrange for another person to pick up your artwork.)

3-Dimensional artwork is limited to a maximum of 3 feet wide x 3 feet deep, not to exceed 50 pounds.

All hanging artwork must be securely hung with stranded wire that is **not visible** when hung. Sawtooth hangers are allowed **only** on metal and glass images. If works are not adequately prepared for display, they will be withdrawn from the show. Please keep in mind that the artist and Guild member who prepares the piece must be able to lift it and display it in a conventionally sized gallery.

LIABILITY - All works will be handled professionally and with care; however, the Guild shall not be held responsible for damage or loss to the artwork.

NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE FOR LATE ENTRIES.

THE DEADLINE FOR CHANGES IS August 28, 2025. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

The Guild will also allow all entrants to display and sell mini-masterpieces during the time of the show.

All entrants will be allowed no more than 3 mini-pieces. Items may be no more than 8" x 10" (framing included in this size) and must be priced at a minimum of \$20.00. Profits from these sales will help to add funds to the Cushman Fund and Scholarship Assistance Program the Guild has with Coastal Carolina University. The Artist will receive 60% of the sale price and the Guild will take a 40% commission. Items not sold at the conclusion of the Spring Show must be removed from the Gallery or may be donated to the Cushman Fund sales grid.
