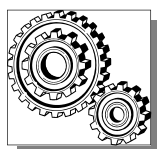

**In the Works**

**Legislative issues for the 2009 session**

Are you interested in becoming involved? CAM is looking for interested and active people to act as liaisons to their church, helping to keep the Christian community informed. Contact CAM at 372-6442.

This is the 9th General Election for which the Christian Action Ministry has provided a survey of the candidates' positions on issues of interest to Christians. To enable you to understand the survey and appreciate the information contained in it, we will provide some insight about the thought process that went into the survey and how we obtained the information that it contains.

The first step in developing a survey is to determine the questions. The members of CAM met to formulate the questions. We wanted them to represent those issues that should be of interest to Christians. Many of the questions would not be asked of the candidates in the normal forums sponsored by various groups. The questions we asked were also geared to determining a candidate's character. How someone stands on an issue, even if it may not come to a vote, can tell you a lot about how they might react to other issues not yet introduced.

Once a first draft of the questions was formulated, we regrouped several times to review them again. We started questions with a key word,

usually SUPPORT or OPPOSE, to clarify the intent of each question and allow a "yes" or "no" answer.

The next step in the survey was to determine who to contact. The 2006 questionnaire polled candidates for the Vermont House and Senate from Chittenden, Franklin, Rutland, Caledonia, Lamoille, Washington, and Grand Isle Counties. This year we have excluded Caledonia and Washington Counties due to low response.

We obtained the candidate list for the primaries from the Secretary of State and prepared letters and questionnaires for them all. The survey was mailed to all the candidates registered in the primary. Independent candidates, those not associated with a recognized party, register later and there is not sufficient time to include them in our survey, although we made an attempt to get answers from them as well.

Not all candidates answered. Some never answer questionnaires. Others don't wish you to know their positions (particularly if they are not favorably inclined to a Christian perspective). Many of the uncontested races saw no need

to reply. We have seen a decline over the years in the number of candidates who respond, and feel this is a regrettable trend. We attempt to make up for this by repeated calls to ask candidates to complete the survey or to give us the information over the telephone. We got some interesting responses, such as, "This conflicts with the separation of church and state", or "Keep religion out of politics". Since morals and values are a part of politics, and there is no constitutional separation of church and state, such candidates are uninformed and shouldn't be running for office.

This year we have included, by permission, WallBuilders [Voter Issue Guide](#) for the Presidential election. We have not included statewide offices since we never get responses in those races.

The final step is setting up a format to display the answers and entering the information as it is received. We hope you will closely review the survey and make an informed decision on November 4th.

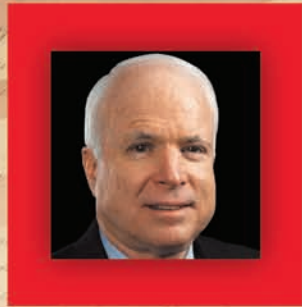
