n Wednesday, August 17, Vermont Governor Peter Shumlin (D) became the first governor in the United States ever to officiate at a same-sex "marriage". In a media display of liberal political correctness, the *Burlington* Free Press celebrated this event which redefined marriage. In the rush to recognize a new "milestone" that our state's chief executive seemed to be establishing, they forgot one very important fact: they were, in actuality, celebrating the morals of ancient Rome and other ancient civilizations. in Islam. The classical teach-


ings of the three major mono-

--- all idol-worshipping, pre-Christian societies which persecuted both Christians and/or Jews, worshipped false gods and goddesses, openly mocked traditional values in their latter stages, and eventually rotted from within and fell. Are these the morals Governor Shumlin hopes Vermont will emulate? The fact that he probably does not consciously intend this, or perhaps is completely unaware of the eventual implications, does not make it

any less true insofar as historical trends and spiritual consequences --- which have repeated themselves over and over again throughout the centuries.

To the argument that "it's the law", it should be noted that all law is based on someone's moral perspective. We are not debating the fact of the existence of such a law here, but its morality. If, as Justinian and countless others after him have said: "The law is a great moral teacher," should we not be certain that all U.S. laws are based on Judeo-Christian morality and principles? No? If we reject that basis, what is left? Or is the base ever malleable, ever shifting? Is our foundation built on solid rock,

or on the quicksand of moral relativism? If we reject Judeo-Christian morality, we will follow ancient Egypt, Greece, and Rome down the sinkhole of history. Psalm 1:1-2 states: "Blessed is the man who does not walk in the counsel of the wicked or stand in the way of sinners or sit in the seat of mockers. But his delight is in the law of the Lord, and on His law he meditates day and night." That verse is not limited. It does not say "Blessed is the king/prince/president/ judge/lawyer etc. who meditates on it day and night", but clearly implies that blessed is the ordinary man or woman who does so. That means all of us --- leaders and citizenry. Upon what law do you meditate? What law do you honor? What law do you celebrate? What law do you willingly follow? Moral law? Amoral law? Immoral law? Where do you place the public media celebration and political embrace of the homosexual lifestyle? The redefinition of marriage? Are there moral absolutes? Does anyone still believe in them? Have we as a state and nation been completely seduced by moral relativism?

It is said that when something is made legal, many people

will think that it is moral as well and accept it, since the law tends to be a moral teacher. Abortion is one example of this. Same-sex marriage may be another. Many people who don't agree at first will succumb to cultural pressure and change their position later. We have certainly seen that in the Vermont legislature, where seven Republicans joined the Democrats and Progressives in voting to overturn former Governor Jim Douglas's (R) veto of the same-sex marriage bill.

It was shocking to open the Free Press and read this article. Have the media and political elites (and the people?) of Vermont become totally desensitized to the increasing homosexualization of our state? As has been mentioned several times in past CAM newsletters, Vermont has been found to be the least religious and the most abortion-friendly state in the nation by various polling research organizations, so perhaps we should not be surprised. Many Vermonters go about their daily lives assuming that these positions are perfectly normal and mainstream. This is not true! Vermont's political and moral culture are not the norm in the United States. We are positioned so far to the left as a state that it cannot help but

affect the general beliefs of the state's population --- and even the beliefs of the people in the churches. Witness the fact that we elect and re-elect an openly -declared socialist to Congress --- despite Article 4, Section 4 of the U.S. Constitution. Our churches (and synagogues) are indeed being affected. To cite but one example, according to nationwide polling data, 30 percent of the youth in evangelical, Bible-believing churches now support samesex marriage. Instead of preaching the truth in love that will set homosexuals free from what all three major world religions say is a sinful lifestyle, and preserve two thousand years of Western culture's definition of marriage, many people either openly affirm those lifestyles, or remain silent. Secular law is indeed acting as a "great moral teacher", and even churched people are influenced by what that law says. Pastors, priests and rabbis have a grave responsibility to their faiths and to western civilization to stand against the morals of ancient Rome, and faithfully teach God's Word in Scripture. We are to love our neighbor, but that does not mean that we must then approve of and embrace all contemporary trends --- even those that are morally unacceptable to Scripture --- in the name of "diversity".

Beginning on August 10, 2011, a group of homosexual activists started a petition on the internet to urge the producers of the Sesame Street children's TV series have puppet characters Bert and Ernie recognized as homosexuals and have them marry in a televised gay wedding. They are also pushing for the addition of a transgendered character to the show. Is this the type of political leadership we are supposed to celebrate? It seems that so-called "gay rights" are not based on the doctrines of any of the three major world religions. Instead, they are based on the false teachings and idolatry of ancient pre-Christian civilizations like Rome, fancied up with contemporary labels such as progressivism, socialism, secular humanism, and liberalism.

Corruption in government at all levels. An honored and professional military scattered throughout the world and tasked with simultaneous multiple conflicts. Loss of control of national borders. Financial chaos in once-solid financial and corporate institutions. Oppressive taxation. Moral decay and rejection of once-honored traditional moral values for experimentation with alternative sexual practices. Pornography. Violence in sports and entertainment. Bread and circuses (the masses entertained by sport and spectacle while their nation crumbled). High divorce rates. Abortion on demand. Cage fighting and gladiatorial-like competitions. Sexual perversity. Drive-by shootings. Generational poverty and dependence on government for financial support. Pedophilia. Polygamy. Fluctuating US policy toward Israel. Scripture says it will be Just as it was in the days of Noah. Can we reverse these trends? It will take prayer and serious involvement by people who can serve as salt and light, as the Bible commands. John Adams, the second U.S. President, once said: "The U.S. Constitution was made only for a religious and moral people. It is wholly inadequate to the government of any other." We are the generation that will either restore the U.S. Constitution or allow it to be lost.

Without prayer and repentance, and the willingness of Christians (and Jews!) to hold fast to the teachings of Scripture and raise the banner of righteousness over our nation, America will go the way of ancient Rome. We will continue our long, slow march into decay. What type of country will emerge on the other side is unknown, but if present trends are left unchecked, history has shown that it will be some form of tyranny --- and our Constitution will have been destroyed in the process. We must pray and repent, humble ourselves, and seek God's face, or America is lost.

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
