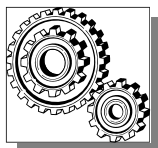

June Seminar with Micah Winefeld

In two of the recent past issues of this newsletter, I have been drawing a picture for you of what has happened to Vermont during the past several decades --- starting in the 1970s with the course MACOS: Man, a Course of Study taught in some of our local schools, which manipulated the minds of our children, and an article from *Playboy* magazine titled “Taking Over Vermont”, which explained how Vermont could be changed from a conservative state to an ultra liberal one. A plan, which I might add, was carried out quite successfully. Now to the final stages of this nightmare.

The last part of the plan to reshape Vermont was called Eugenics. It began as a study to improve the human race. Margaret Sanger, the founder of Planned Parenthood, was deeply involved in eugenics, but she was not the only one. The Nazis embraced the theo-

ries of eugenics and building a master race. While browsing the internet in 2004, I came across an article entitled “Eugenics: Building Better



Vermonters (toward a total administrative society” by Jerry L. Snay. I would like to share some of what was written in this article. Snay begins by saying, “As Nancy Gal-

agher states in the opening sentence of her book, Breeding Better Vermonters, ‘Eugenics means different things to different people.’” Snay then states: “After reading many of the Vermont Eugenics Files, I would like to offer some additional perspectives . . . It is often said that UVM’s Dr. Perkins was motivated by his being a Vermonter, a Protestant, and a Nationalist. Whether these were primary concerns of Dr. Perkins is arguable. Dr. Perkins was certainly a privileged individual insulated from the lives of common Vermonters and viewed most Vermonters as lab rats. His ‘Protestant identity’ was a social structure of the upper class Vermonter . . . Dr. Perkins and many of his fraternal and academic peers (Eastern Establishment) had a strong affinity towards ‘Materialism’, Social Darwinism, Secular Humanism, Communism/Socialism, Eugenics, Robber Baron Capitalism, and

the Nazis. [They] were useful to the Eugenic Societies' financial benefactors. These people were philanthropists such as the Rockefellers, Carnegies, etc. who were interested in larger agendas such as internationalism (the Global Community), and later funding the United Nations, which has its own population control programs. These same philanthropic foundations are still funding many social and environmental globalist programs in Vermont and the world, i.e. 'Agenda 21' at the U.N. Any observant Vermonter can see that Planned Parenthood and the eugenics movement has gone global."

The article goes on to speak of Sanger and Planned Parenthood: "The beauty of this scheme (eugenics and population control) was that the masses could exterminate themselves, while claiming they were exercising some perceived rights at the same time." Sounds like "Pro choice", "My body, My choice", and "I have the right to an abortion", doesn't it? Now that we have our state and national governments funding Planned Parenthood, and President Obama using his executive authority to sign off

on the U.N.'s **Agenda 21** plan, we can see the political agenda founded on eugenics spreading like a cancer in our state, our nation, and throughout the world.

Jerry Snay's article goes on to ask if eugenics is still with us today. He explains that one area where it has had great influence is in education. In fact, he calls it "one of the best examples. The state's 'School to Work' plan closely resembles the agenda of the Vermont Eugenics Files, working in partnership to facilitate social control with their 'cradle to grave' slogan", and the 'One Stop Shopping' of social programs. Other connected programs are 'Success by Six' . . .", and more recently Senator Bernie Sanders's idea to pass a bill called "Foundations for Success Act of 2011" (S294), placing all children from infancy to school age in a state-run pre-school program that I spoke of in the September-October 2011 CAM newsletter. Through these intrusive state government programs and new agencies, they have expanded government control over the lives of Vermonters, and literally destroyed the Vermont some of us knew as children. Total state control of our healthcare was only the logical next step.

Abraham Lincoln once said, "The philosophy of the classroom will be the philosophy of the next generation."

If we are to return Vermont to its roots we must say, "The buck stops here." We are no longer willing to be owned by the government (the company store). We are independent people. We do not belong to the state. We belong to Jesus Christ. We are a free people. We are free to own our own homes, free to send our children to the schools of our choice or free to teach them at home, free to decide for ourselves what we will make of our lives, and what we will leave as an inheritance to our children and grandchildren. It is up to us: WE THE PEOPLE. We still have the freedom to vote and to use our own minds to think with.

I may not have been born in Vermont, but my father and his family were and I am honored to be able to say the town in which I now live was named after my ancestor. All my family are buried in a local cemetery in Lamoille County. I graduated from Peoples Academy and I am proud of my Vermont roots. But I am not proud of the road Vermont has taken and it is my desire to see the

pendulum swing the other way, back to the state President Calvin Coolidge spoke of in an address he gave in Bennington on September 21, 1928. He said, in part: "Vermont is a state I love . . . here my dead lie pillowed on the loving breast of our everlasting hills! I love Vermont because of her hills and valleys, her scenery and invigorating climate, but most of all because of her indomitable people. They are a race of pioneers who have almost beggared themselves to serve others. If the spirit of liberty should vanish in other parts of the Union and support of institutions should languish, it could all be replenished from the generous store held by the people of this brave little State of Vermont."

Micah graduated in 1972 from Grace College (Winona Lake, IN) with a B.A. degree in Bible. He is a 1975 Master of Divinity honor graduate of Grace Theological Seminary (Winona Lake, IN). While in seminary he was the part-time pastor of an independent church, Tippecanoe Christian Church near Winamac, Indiana (1972-1975). He has had three full-time pastorates: GBC of Elyria, Ohio (1975-1979), GBC of Covington, Virginia (1979-1984), and GBC of Telford, Tennessee (1984-1997).

He founded Prophecy Today Ministries in 1990 and has been very active in Bible prophecy conferences since that time. Since 1997 he has been the full-time director of this ministry.

In the last 25 years he has traveled to the Middle East eighteen times and has become familiar with the political, social, economical, and spiritual trends in the region. His careful study of the prophetic Scriptures, traveling experiences, and Scriptural analysis of world events, give him a keen insight into current events. Since 1997, his conference ministry has included more than 500 prophetic conferences in 170 churches in 22 states in the U.S., and in New Zealand, and Canada. His Bible prophecy newsletter has a circulation of more than 8,000 in the U.S. and 10 foreign countries. His messages demonstrate in a very conservative way how current events are setting the stage for the final events of the end-times.

In addition to his Bible Prophecy Conference ministry he also annually hosts tours to Israel, Jordan, Egypt, Greece, and Turkey (the lands of the Bible). He has also spoken in several Christian schools, jails, nursing homes, plus several radio and TV talk shows. In recent years his ministry has covered America from shore to shore, from Virginia to California and from Florida to Maine. He is the author of several publications and the editor of the monthly 8-page “PTNews” newsletter (published since 1990).
