We broke our question into four sections to mirror the Declaration of Independence and labeled them Unalienable Rights, Life, Liberty, and Pursuit of Happiness. Many of the questions would not be

asked of the candidates in the normal forums sponsored by various groups. The questions we asked were also geared to determining a candidate's character. How someone stands on an issue, even if it may not come to a vote, can tell you a lot about how they might react to other issues not yet introduced.

We started questions with a key word, usually SUPPORT or OPPOSE, to clarify the intent of each question and allow a "yes" or "no" answer. If the response contained comments that made the answer unclear, it was marked as "undecided".

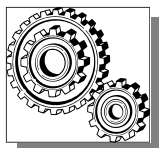
The next step in the survey was to determine who to contact. The 2014 questionnaire polled candidates for Governor and Lt. Governor; and the Vermont House and Senate from Chittenden, Franklin, Rutland, Grand Isle, and Lamoille Counties.

Not all candidates answered. Some never answer questionnaires. Others don't wish you to know their positions (particularly if they are not favorably inclined to a Chris-

tian perspective). Some of the uncontested races saw no need to reply. We have seen a decline over the years in the number of candidates who respond, and feel this is a regrettable trend. We attempt to make up for this by repeated calls to ask candidates to complete the survey or to give us the information over the telephone. We also use other sources or past surveys if the current questionnaire is not returned.

The final step is setting up a format to display the answers, and entering the information as it is received. We hope you will closely review the survey and make an informed decision on November 6th.
