Do Not Remain Silent!

For the secret of evil is even now at work: but there is one who is keeping back the evil till he is taken out of the way. (2 Thessalonians 2:7 BBE)

Recently, I wrote the letter below to my local newspaper. The incident occurred beyond the distribution area of the paper and the individual will probably never see it, but others will. We must not remain silent in the face of lies nor other evil.

"As I write this, news is breaking about a deadly attack on a synagogue in New York state, but I've been thinking about it since Thursday when I saw someone carrying a sign on a rural road in New York state. The sign read, "Jews want your guns." Now, why should this fellow American be so timid in exercising his freedom of speech that he chose a rural road where almost no one would see his sign?

Perhaps he doesn't know that Jewish American Aaron Solomon was among the patriots at Bunker Hill defending his freedom of speech. Perhaps he doesn't know that Jewish patriots, Abraham Levy and Phillip Russell, suffered along with George Washington and other Americans at Valley Forge.

Perhaps he doesn't know that there are over 5,000 Jewish graves in Arlington National Cemetery. After all, until 1918, only crosses were used to mark graves. [Our bad.]

As well as Jewish members of the Union Army buried in Arlington, there is also Moses Ezekiel who was among the Confederate ranks. Not everyone in a group will have the same perspective. Yes, there are Americans who advocate tighter gun control. There is no reason to think that none of them are Jewish, especially when we consider the rise in hate crimes. There is also no reason to think that all people of any demographic hold the same view on an issue or that those who do should not exercise their freedom of assembly.

If he knew of all the Jewish people who have defended both his First and Second Amendment rights, the sign maker may have had more courage to express his opinion. He also may have reconsidered his opinion."

Some might respond to overt anti-Semitism or other evil by mocking the sign maker: "He chose a rural road because he wasn't sure he had spelled all the words correctly." That response socially isolates the man who is probably already socially isolated and makes the mocker feel superior. It does not refute the claim of the sign nor will such sophistry work against others embracing the claim.

Better a response that embraces the sign maker, in this case as a fellow American with common rights, building a bridge rather than a barrier. Refute the claim with readily available facts. Identify the claim as opinion, not reality. Will he abandon the lie? Perhaps, perhaps not, but you have worked together with "one who is keeping back the evil."

This virus has brought out both the best and the worse in people and institutions. Among the best are our first responders: doctors, nurses, EMTs, police, fire, truckers, sanitation workers, grocery and essential merchandise employees, and benevolent organizations like food banks and the Salvation Army and Samaritan's Purse.

Among the worst were the secular media, the UN and WHO who avoided offend-

ing China at all costs, and politicians who used this pandemic as an excuse to tyrannize and bully their constituents, closing churchallowing liquor stores and gay swingers clubs and abortion clinics to remain really have a problem with remain open, any more than I have a problem with allowing gun stores and grocery stores to remain open. Four months later, emerging on the other side of this, we are now receiving information daily that in many cases casts doubt on what we were told earlier. That really isn't your side, and ten thousand the biggest problem, however.

> The major problem is that the media and politicians in many states used this virus as an excuse to either propagandize or terrorize their own citizens and

strip them of many Constitutional and religious liberties and protections in ways I have not seen in my lifetime. The curve is much flatter, but many states are still locked down. Now we are being given different reasons. This was done in mostly liberal states headed by Democratic governors, but also in a few States headed by liberal Republican governors, such as in

In the beginning of this, I didn't know any more about it than the next person. I heard it was bad. I heard it would kill millions. I prayed to Jesus and asked Him for protection from this pandemic.

He gave me (this was personal only) two Bible verses which I have trusted for months now. One was, "A thousand shall fall at at your right hand, but no evil will come near you." (Psalm 91:7)

Personally, I do not believe God sent this plague upon us. I believe unscrupulous men created it, and then lost control of it. However, I do believe God might have allowed it (not stopped it) as a



wakeup call to a planet that is more and more rejecting Him and going its own way. The evidence is before our very eyes. Even as people died around us, we continued to embrace human sacri- Michigan, California, New fice in Planned Parenthood and other abortion clinics, spilling the blood of innocent babies even as we begged God to have mercy on us. What a sad group of hypocrites we humans are. I cuted so His followers have been thinking that maybe God pushed the PAUSE button on us so we might repent and turn to Him in the midst of this disaster. I know many did, and more people than ever have become open to hearing the Gospel. I have firsthand experience of this during the past several months.

However, the nation as a whole has not repented. A church in Mississippi that had not followed the governor's order forbidding churches to conduct inperson services was burned to the ground one night, and a message spray-painted on the parking lot: "Bet you stay home now, hypokrits." That qualifies as a hate crime, by the way. The American Center for Law and Justice, First Liberty, the Thomas Moore Center, and Liberty Counsel are just a few of the law firms involved in many lawsuits on behalf of churches who are suing their states for unconstitutional lockdowns of houses of worship. New

York City Mayor Bill DeBlasio stated that he would like to close his city's churches and synagogues permanently. Several governors, notably in Virginia, York and New Jersey, have displayed strong hostility to religion during this epidemic. Jews have also come under attack. Remember that Jesus said as He was persewould be.

In an essay mailed to supporters at the end of May, titled "Satan's Open War on Churches", Mat Staver, lead attorney for Liberty Counsel, stated the following: "As we approach Pentecost Sunday, the traditional birth date of Christ's Church, one thing is clear --- Satan has declared open war on America's churches. Over the past several months, governors and local officials have taken it upon themselves to deny Americans their First Amendment right to religious freedom, demanding church closures . . ." and arresting, citing, imposing fines, and threatening pastors (and a few rabbis) who refused to comply. He went on to say: "As of this writing (May 27) four pastors we now represent have been served with CRIMINAL complaints and three have been threatened with jail time for opening their churches. One entire congregation we represent in Kentucky was put under the equivalent of 14 days house

arrest through an arbitrary forced quarantine order, causing several members to lose their jobs, even though not one attendee had been tested, let alone had tested positive, for the corona virus. A church we do not represent (in a lawsuit) in Holly Springs, Mississippi was firebombed the explosion leveled most of the building and the words "Bet you stay home now hypokrits" were spray painted across the parking lot. The city of Chicago threatened two Romanian churches we represent with SUM-MARY ABATEMENT --- a process through which the city could bulldoze the church building should pastors or church members continue meeting in person on the church property." I would note that this is what Communist China does to churches. Staver goes on to say that we Americans need to fight for our churches (his words) because they are being persecuted by the thousands. Liberty Counsel is currently defending persecuted pastors and congregations all over the country, and "providing legal counsel to (many American) churches shocked by the oppression of their religious freedom. We have been deluged by calls for help. Who would have ever thought this could happen in America? With our legal guidance, over 3,000 California churches and several thousand others nationwide will open on Pentecost Sunday,

with or without their governor's permission."

There are numerous signs that tell us we are living in the last days as foretold in Scripture. We must be like the five wise virgins. We must have the oil in our lamps ready, for we know not the hour when Jesus will return with a shout and catch His followers up to be with Him as hell is unleashed upon the earth. Churches that have neglected teaching their modern congregations about the rapture and the End Times need to start preaching about these events once again, for they are upon us. The rapture is called "the Blessed Hope." This hope must be preached as churches reopen! God allowed the PAUSE button to be pushed, but America as a nation has not truly repented, although individual people have repented and been saved. "But," you say, "There will be a great revival." To that I say, what are YOU personally doing to bring it about? How many souls have you tried to win to Jesus during this troubled time? The time is ripe and people are open to hearing the Gospel. With how many people have you shared last days teaching, and the truth of salvation, or are you hiding behind your mask? Just get out there and DO IT!
