No commercial booths are allowed.
- 6. Each Exhibitor will be assigned a 12'wide x 10'deep space. Only one exhibitor per space. One tent per site.
- 7. This is an outdoor show; there is no completely level ground. To be fair to all exhibitors, booth spaces will be assigned randomly. Set-up, take-down, and designated parking will be strictly adhered to. Arrival late or leaving early will not be tolerated. Any exhibitor who leaves the area early will not be allowed to exhibit in the future.

8. NO PETS IN THE EXHIBITING AREA

- **9. Exhibitors are responsible for care and protection of their exhibit area.** The Friends of McIntosh will not assume responsibility. Exhibitors are responsible for the overall appearance of their booths which should reflect the professionalism of the promotion. All refuse must be removed from the premises upon leaving.
